WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

WHEREAS, the recognition u/s 14 Act of NCTE, 1993 was granted to the institution namely, **Sri Sathya Sai Institute of Higher Learning, Plot/Khasara No. 451/2,3,4, Ex3, 86,4,25,74.6, Anantapur Post and Taluk, Anantapur City and District – 515001, Andhra Pradesh** vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/SRCAPP1108/M.Ed./AP/2015/62160 dt. 03.03.2015 for conducting M.Ed. programme of two year duration with an annual intake of 50 students from the academic session 2015-2016.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution had consented to come under new Regulations vide a notarized affidavit dated 29.01.2015. A revised provisional recognition order was issued on 26.05.2015 to the institution for conducting M.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students (one basic unit) from the academic session 2015-16.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 388<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 14<sup>th</sup> – 15<sup>th</sup> September, 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN/FSCN in all RPRO cases asking them to submit all the required documents as per the 13 points. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 22.02.2021. The institution has submitted its reply on 15.03.2021. The institution has submitted reply on 11.06.2022 mentioned in affidavit the institution has not admitted any students for M.Ed. course from the academic session 2015-2016 to till date.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 412<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 05<sup>th</sup> – 06<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 has considered the matter and the following observations were made:

*“The Committee noted that the institution has mentioned in affidavit the institution has not admitted any students for M.Ed. course from the academic session 2015-2016 to till date. In view of same the Committee agreed to withdrawal the recognition granted to Sri Sathya Sai Institute of Higher Learning, Plot/Khasara No. 451/2,3,4 ,Ex3 ,86 ,4,25,74,6 Anantapur Post & Taluk, Anantapur City & District-515001, Andhra Pradesh for conducting M.Ed. Programme as requested by the Registrar under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993.*

*However, the FDRs towards Reserve Fund and Endowment Fund/ No Objection Certificate (NOC) for encashment of FDRs will be issued by the Regional Director as per the general resolution taken by the SRC in this meeting.”*

5. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby agreed to close down by withdrawing the recognition granted to **Sri Sathya Sai Institute of Higher Learning, Plot/Khasara No. 451/2,3,4 ,Ex3 ,86 ,4,25,74,6 Anantapur Post & Taluk, Anantapur City & District-515001**.

**Andhra Pradesh** for running **M.Ed. Programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of **50 students (one basic unit)** as requested.

6. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

***“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”***

7. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through “online mode” available on NCTE’s website [www.ncte-india.org](http://www.ncte-india.org) within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE’s website.
