**WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

WHEREAS, recognition u/s 14 Act of NCTE, 1993 was granted to the institution namely, **Kalpataru College of Education, B.H. Road, Tirupur, Tumkur District, Karnataka-572202** run by **Kalpataru Vidya Samsthe, Tiptur, Tumkur District, Karnataka** vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2004-2005/8786 dt. 24.12.2004 for B.Ed. course of one year duration from the academic session 2004-2005 with an annual intake of 100 students.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 239<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 26<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup> February 2013 decides to withdraw recognition of the B.Ed. course. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC Withdrawal Order was issued vide order no. F.SRO.NCTE/APS01885/B.Ed./KA/2012-13/50344 on dt. 03.04.2013 to the institution.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, aggrieved by the order of the SRC, the institution preferred an Appeal before the Appellate Authority of the NCTE. The Appellate Authority vide order No. 89-312/2014 Appeal/12<sup>th</sup> Meeting-2014 dated 25.11.2014 appeal committee concluded that with the issue of Appeal Order dated 08.07.2014 the recognition for grant of B.Ed. course given to the appellant institution in 2004-05 stands restored and the withdrawal order dated 20.06.2014 becomes non-existent.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit on 03.01.2015 for its willingness of two units in B.Ed. course and adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, an order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APS01885/B.Ed./KA/2014-2015/61351 was issued to the institution on 29.01.2015 for restored/continued the recognition.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, a Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on 31.05.2015 for conducting **B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.**

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 375<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 13<sup>th</sup> – 14<sup>th</sup> May 2019 has considered the matter and decided to issue a Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 23.05.2019. The institution has not submitted any reply to the Show Cause Notice till the date.

8. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 411<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 23<sup>rd</sup> – 24<sup>th</sup> May, 2022 has considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 03.06.2022. The institution did not submit any reply to the Final Show Cause Notice. However, they have submitted written representation on 13.06.2022.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 414<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 26<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup> September, 2022 considered the matter and decided as under: -

*"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made were made: -*


*The institution was given Show Cause Notice dated 23.05.2019. the institution has not submitted any reply in response to the Show Cause Notice. Thereafter a Final Show Cause Notice was issued on 03.06.2022 however the institution has not submitted any reply in response to the Final Show Cause Notice.*

1. *Staff list duly approved by the affiliating body as per the prescribed Format has not been submitted.*
2. *Original Form "A" alongwith FDR of Rs.7 lakh and 5 lakh, totalling Rs.12 lakh towards Endowment Fund & Reserve Fund into joint account for a duration of 5 years has not been submitted*
3. *A copy of the approved Building Plan (if institution is running more than one Teacher Education programme, it shall be required to submit an exclusive earmarked building plan for each of the recognised Teacher Education programme) has not been submitted.*
4. *Building Completion Certificate as per prescribed Format has not been submitted.*
5. *The institution has not been submitted certified copy of land documents. (If the same are in Regional Language the institution is also required to submit notarised copy of English version of land documents)*
6. *Land Use Certificate issued by the Competent Authority has not been submitted.*
7. *Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by the Competent Authority has not been submitted.*

*Hence the recognition granted to **Kalpataru College of Education, B.H. Road, Tirpur-572202, Tumkur District, Karnataka** for **B.Ed. course** is withdrawn under Section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 from the academic year **2023-2024**. On withdrawal of recognition, the affiliation if any granted under Clause 8(10) of NCTE Regulation, 2014 by the concerned affiliating body from the next academic session stands withdrawn."*


7. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraw the recognition granted to **Kalpataru College of Education, B.H. Road, Tirpur-572202, Tumkur District, Karnataka** run by **Kalpataru Vidya Samsthe, Tiptur, Tumkur District, Karnataka -572202** for conducting **B.Ed. programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of **100 students (2 basic units)** with effect from the next academic session i.e., 2023-2024 onwards.

8. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -



***“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”***

9. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through “online mode” available on NCTE’s website [www.ncte-india.org](http://www.ncte-india.org) within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE’s website.
