ORDER

In terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Andhra Saraswatha Parishath Telugu Pandit Training College, Tilak Road, Hyderabad - 500 001, Andhra Pradesh** had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for recognition to restart **Telugu Pandit Training Course** of One year duration from the academic session **2002-03** with an annual intake of **50** students.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:

- i) The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- ii) The institution has made arrangements for conducting the course in rented premises.
- iii) The institution has created an Endowment Fund of Rs.1.00 lakh and a Reserve Fund of Rs. 0.50 lakh.
- iv) The institution has selected the Principal / Head and 04 teachers for the said course.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **Andhra Saraswatha Parishath Telugu Pandit Training College, Tilak Road, Hyderabad - 500 001, Andhra Pradesh** for **Telugu Pandit Training Course** of One year duration from the academic session **2002-2003** with an annual intake of 50 students subject to fulfillment of the following :

- a) The institution will ensure that 1+4 faculty members are in position for an intake of 50 students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Committee within one month of commencement of the course.
- b) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
- c) The institution shall shift to its own premises within three years from the date of recognition (In case the course is started in rented premises).
- d) The recognition now accorded is subject to review after the NCTE formulates and prescribes its own norms applicable to the Language Teacher Training Course.

4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC and the State Government etc.

5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating University / State Directorate of Education to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant
6. If the institution contravenes any of the above condition or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the Provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
