WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely Navodaya College of Education, Nager Kurnool, Mehaboobnagar Dt., Andhra Pradesh vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.AP/B.Ed/NEW/54/SRO/NCTE/2000-2001/1581 dt. 14.08.2000 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

AND WHEREAS, the matter of shifting premises from temporary to permanent premises for B.Ed course in the State of Andhra Pradesh was placed before SRC in its 178th meeting held on 13th-14th July 2009. The committee decided to issue notice under section 17 of NCTE Act and call all documents of new premises/building.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dt.22.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 12.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (Two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, the institution vide letter dated 17.06.2015 for submission of compliance report for shifting of premises from temporary to permanent submitted. The SRC in its 315th meeting held on 17th & 18th June, 2016 considered the shifting case and it has decided as under :

1. *They have shifted without permission.*
2. *Collect fee and cause inspection for B.Ed (2 units)*
3. *BP is not approved.*
4. *Original FDRs and latest faculty list have not been submitted.*
5. *Ask VT to collect all relevant documents and specifically check on built-up area.*
6. *They have asked for increase intake from 100 to 150. We cannot consider it at this stage. They should have applied on-line at the appropriate time. Also, now there is a ban on B.Ed in Telangana for 2017-18.*

AND WHEREAS, the institution submitted original DD of Rs. 1,50,000/- bearing No. 021582 dated 30.07.2016 and other relevant documents on 01.08.2016. Inspection letter was sent to the institution on 12.07.2016. The inspection of the institution was conducted on 24.08.2016 and the VT report along with documents and CD received on 01.08.2016. The SRC in its 321st meeting held on 28th & 29th September, 2016 considered the VT report and decided to issue show cause notice. Accordingly, a show cause notice was issued on 24.10.2016.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 324th meeting held on 7th & 8th December, 2016 considered the show cause notice reply and decided to issue show cause notice. Accordingly, a show cause notice was issued on 16.12.2016.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 381st meeting held on 31st Oct 01st Nov 2019 considered the matter and decided to issued SCN in all such matters where the institution has not submitted the following requisite documents/VT report not accompanied with the requisite documents in response to RPRO issued by the SRC. Accordingly Final Show Cause Notice was issued on 21.11.2019. The institution submitted its reply on 20.02.2020 stating therein that new Committee will communicate with SRC, NCTE.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 387th Meeting held on 24th – 25th August, 2020 considered the matter and decided as under:-

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN) dated 21.11.2019. The institution has submitted its reply on 20.02.2020 stating therein that new Committee will communicate with SRC, NCTE in all further negotiations which is not acceptable.

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to Navodaya College of Education, Nagarkurnool, Mahaboobnagar District, Telangana for conducting B.Ed. course w.e.f. the 2020-21 academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of Navodaya College of Education, Nager Kurnool, Mehaboobnagar District, Telangana for conducting B.Ed. programme of two year duration with an annual intake of 100 students (2 units) from the next academic session starts after issuance of this order.


Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school,

College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
