WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely Dr. M.R. Reddy College of Education, Dr. M.R. Reddy College Road, Parkal – 506164, Warangal, Andhra Pradesh vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.AP/B.Ed/92/SRO/NCTE/200-2001/8334 dt 22.10.01 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

AND WHEREAS, the recognition was withdrawn to the above institution vide order No. F.AP/NEW/B.Ed/92/2003-2004/539 dated 24.12.2003 as the Principal appointed by the institution was not qualified as per NCTE norms.

AND WHEREAS, the institution filed a Writ Petition No. 2086/2004 against the withdrawal of recognition and the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature, Andhra Pradesh at Hyderabad has passed an oral order. The above matter was placed before SRC in its 69th meeting held on 13th February, 2004 and SRC decided to accord recognition to Dr. M.R. Reddy College of Education, Parkal from the academic session 2003-2004 with an intake of 112.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dt 19.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 11.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic unit) from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC issued a Corrigendum vide Order No. F.SRO/NCTE/APS00044/B.Ed/TS/2015-16/85795 dated 01.06.2016 to the institution two basic unit.

AND WHEREAS, the institution has submitted an application dated 12.07.2016 requesting therein for reduction of strength from 2 units to 1 unit in its B.Ed course. The above matter was placed before SRC in its 342nd meeting held on 05th & 06th July, 2017 and the committee decided to reduce the intake from 2 units to 1 unit.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC issued a vide order no. F.No. SRO/NCTE/APS00044/B.Ed/TS/2017-18/94094 dated 21.07.2017 to the institution reduce the intake from 2 units to 1 unit.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the Committee Decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institution which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a show cause notice issued to the institution on 28.02.2019. The institution has submitted dated 23.03.2019 reply to the show cause notice.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 381st meeting held on 31st Oct 01st Nov 2019 considered the matter and decided to issued SCN in all such matters where the institution has not submitted the following requisite documents/VT report not accompanied with the requisite documents in response to RPRO issued by the SRC. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a Final Show

Cause Notice was issued on 14.11.2019. The institution vide letter dated 05.12.2019 submitted its reply to the Final Show Cause Notice.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 387th Meeting held on 24th – 25th August, 2020 considered the matter and decided as under:-

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

On the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution on 05.12.2019. The Committee observed and found the following deficiencies: -

1. The institution has not submitted certified copy of land documents.
2. The institution has not submitted certified copy of land use certificate.
3. Survey no. is not mentioned in building plan.
4. Date of inspection and multipurpose hall is not mentioned in BCC. BCC submitted is not in the prescribed NCTE format.
5. Photocopy of staff list along with letter from Kakatiya University approved by the Registrar, Kakatiya University consisting of one principal, 7 assistant professors submitted dated NIL for the session 2019-2020.
 - a) The staff list submitted by the institution is not in the prescribed NCTE Format.
 - b) The principal does not possess a Ph.D. degree.
 - c) Percentage of marks not given in the staff list.
6. The institution has not submitted copy of Form 'A' issued by the Branch Manager and the photocopies of FDR has been expired. The institution is required to submit Form "A" issued by the bank manager towards creation of FDR of Rs. 7 lakh & Rs. 5 lakhs towards Endowment Fund & Reserve Fund.

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **Dr. M.R.Reddy College of Education, Parkal-506164, Warangal District, Andhra Pradesh** for conducting **B.Ed.** course w.e.f. the 2020-21 academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of **Dr. M.R. Reddy College of Education, Parkal-506164, Warangal District, Telangana** for conducting **B.Ed.** programme of two year duration with an annual intake of **50** students (1 units) w.e.f. the next academic session.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission

under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
