WHEREAS, recognition was granted to the institution namely Vidyavan Womens College of Education, Kakinada Revenue Division, #70-18-1/1, Vidyavan Campus, Kakinada, East Godavari District- 533005, Andhra Pradesh run by Krishna Institute of Medical Technology Society, Kakinada, East Godavari District- 533005, Andhra Pradesh vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.AP/NEW/B.Ed/217/SRO/NCTE/2002-2003/6718 Dt. 17.04.2003 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year with an annual intake 120 students from the academic session 2002-2003.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dt.28.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, thereafter provisional revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 06.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, on the basis of request, the SRC in its 342nd Meeting decided for reduction of intake from 2 Units to 1 Unit. Accordingly a order vide order no. F.No.SRO/NCTE/APSO0229/B.Ed/AP/2017-18/94110 dt. 21.07.2017 was issued to the institution.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in 381th meeting held on 31st Oct & 1st Nov, 2019 decided to issue Show Cause Notice to all such institution where reply to RPRO/VT report has not been submitted by the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 06.12.2019. The institution did not submit the reply to the Show Cause Notice.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 383rd Meeting held on 7th, 8th and 9th January 2020 considered the matter and decided as under:-

- (i) The Management of the Institution had not submitted required documents in response to Show Cause Notice (SCN) issued to the Institution on 06.12.2019.
- (ii) The Dean, Adikavi Nannaya University, Andhra Pradesh vide letter No. No.ANUR/CDC/Edu./NCTE/Information/2019-20/01 dated 19.11.2019, has informed that the University has discontinued the extension of affiliation from the academic year 2016-17 to 2019-20 in respect of the institution VidyavanWomens College of Education, Kakinada Revenue Division, #70-18-1/1, Vidyavan Campus, Kakinada, East Godavari District- 533005, Andhra Pradesh."

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to VidyavanWomens College of Education, Kakinada Revenue Division, #70-18-1/1, Vidyavan Campus, Kakinada, East Godavari District- 533005, Andhra Pradesh for conducting B.Ed. course w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.
