WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, B.T.K B.Ed college of Eduction, Manapparai Road, Opp EB Office, Viralamalai, Pudukottai, Thanjavur District 621316, Tamilnadu run by B.T.K Educational Development Trust, No 5 M.P Avenue, Majestic Colony, Saligraman, Chennai Tamilnadu-600093 vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed/2006-2007/6290 dt. 13.07.2007 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution submitted affidavit dt. 27.10.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, the revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 30.04.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (Two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, as per the decision a first Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 21.11.2019.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 380th meeting held on 18th -19th September 2019 wherein the Committee considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, Final Show Cause Notice was issued on 21.11.2019.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was finally considered by the SRC in its 384^{th} meeting held on $12^{th} - 13^{th}$ February 2020 decided as under:-

"The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The Management of the Institution had not submitted required documents in response to Show Cause Notice (SCN) issued to the Institution on 05.08.2019 in M.Ed and 21.11.2019 in B.Ed. Another opportunity was given to the institution by serving a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN) dated 05.11.2019. The institution vide letter dated 05.12.2019 submitted its reply/representation in response to Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN). On perusal of the same the Committee found the following defects / shortcomings / deficiencies as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 which are as under:-

 The institution has submitted notarized copy of xerox copy of Sale Deed dt. 24.02.2005. The LUC in respect of total 22 S. No. (10.69 Acres) has been submitted

- but land documents submitted onlyin respect of 8 S. No. Further, there are difference in Survey number of LUC with land continuity certificate.
- 2. The size of class rooms and Multi Purpose Hall are less than the requirement of NCTE Regulations.
- 3. The institution has submitted notarized copy of xerox copy of site plan which is also approved in regional language.
 - a. The institution has submitted notarized copy of xerox copy of Land Usage Certificate. Further the LUC in not in proper format of State Govt.
- b. The institution has submitted notarized copy of xerox copy of NEC dt. 26.08.2019 but in regional language also the same is not legible.
- c. The faculty is not sufficient for both courses as per NCTE, Regulations. Further, the signature of the Registrar, TNTEU are not available on the last pages of proforma of faculty for both courses. All pages of proforma are xerox copy and last pages are signed by correspondent of institute originally without signature of Registrar.
- d. The institution has not submitted website details of the institution as per NCTE guidelines.

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to B.T.K B.Ed. College of Education, Thanjavur District, Tamilandu-621316 for conducting B.Ed. & M.Ed courses w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above."

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to B.T.K B.Ed college of Eduction, Manapparai Road, Opp EB Office, Viralamalai, Pudukottai, Thanjavur District 621316, Tamilnadu run by B.T.K Educational Development Trust, No 5 M.P Avenue, Majestic Colony, Saligraman, Chennai Tamilnadu-600093 for running B.Ed course of 2 basic units of 100 students from the end of the academic session. The withdrawal recognition is effective for academic session commences next to issuance of this order.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order Withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal u/s 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org, with 60 days from By Order, Al Mose the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filling appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
