WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the institution V.S. Isaac College of Education, No.126, Attupakkam Village, Arakkonam, Taluk, Vellore-631051, Tamilnadu was granted recognition vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.TN/SEC/154/SRO/NCTE/2004-2005/03 dated 01.04.2005 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year' duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2004-2005.

AND WHEREAS, the institution V.S. Isaac College of Education, No.126, Attupakkam Village, Arakkonam, Taluk, Vellore-631051, Tamilnadu was granted recognition vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed.-AI/2008-09/4088 dated 22.08.2008 for conducting B.Ed.-AI course of one year' duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2008-2009.

AND WHEREAS, the institution namely V.S. Isaac College of Education, No.126, Attupakkam Village, Arakkonam, Taluk, Vellore-631051, Tamilnadu was granted recognition for conducting M.Ed. course of one year' duration with an annual intake of 25 students from the academic session 2006-2007 vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/M.Ed./2006-2007/13911 dt.01.11.2007. The intake of M.Ed. course was enhanced on the basis of NCTE (amendment) Regulations, 2010 from 25 to 35.

AND WHEREAS, the promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014 and as per affidavits submitted by the institution on dt. 29.01.2015, the provisional revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 12.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years' duration with an annual intake of 100 from the academic session 2015-16 and in respect of B.Ed.-AI course affidavit submitted by the institution on dt.29.01.2015 and the Revised Provisional Revised Recognition Order was issued to the institution on 18.03.2015 for conducting B.Ed.-AI course of two years' duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-2016 and in respect of M.Ed. course affidavits submitted by the institution on dt.29.01.2015 and the Revised Provisional Revised Recognition Order was issued to the institution on 25.05.2015 for conducting M.Ed. course of two years' duration with an annual intake of 50 students (one unit) from the academic session 2015-2016.

AND WHEREAS, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance.

AND WHEREAS, as per the decision a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 26.04.2019. Meanwhile, the institution had filed a W.P.No.20466/2019 for restraining the NCTE

from insisting the petitioner to comply the condition of the 2014 Regulations. Here, it is informed that there is no orders/ stay from the Hon'ble Court.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 380th meeting held on 18th – 19th September, 2019 wherein the Committee considered the matter and decided to issue **Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of NCTE Act.** Accordingly, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 09.10.2019.

AND WHEREAS, the institution has submitted its reply on 31.10.2019 in respect of SCN issued above.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 382nd meeting held on 26th -27th November, 2019 considered the matter and decided as under: -

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following deficiency/observations were made:-

(i) The institution had submitted photocopy of FDRs attached with 'Form A' issued by the Karur Vysya Bank of Rs.5 Lakhs, Rs.3 lakhs and Rs.3 Lakhs. FDRs for B.Ed. and D.T.Ed. Courses not submitted.

(ii) Photocopy of staff list was submitted for B.Ed. and M.Ed. Course which was not approved by the Registrar of the affiliating body as per the NCTE Regulations. The institute had only submitted a photocopy of letter dt.25.07.2012 issued by the TTEU regarding approval of 11 faculty members in B.Ed. course out of which C. Jayaseeli, S. Prema, K. Vijayalakshmi, J.Valarmathi and T.Pandiyan are not qualified. Further approval of faculty for M.Ed. and D.T.Ed. Courses have not been submitted.

(iii) The institution submitted in Regional Language.

(iv) The institution submitted a photocopy of notarized copy of Land Use Certificate in Regional Language.

(v) The institution has submitted copy of Sale Deed in favour of: S. Isaac Jebakumar, S/o Mr. J. Selvadurai. The institute did not submit originally certified copy of land documents. Further, the land is in the name of an individual.

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognitions** granted to **V.S. Isaac College of Education, No.126, Attupakkam Village, Arakkonam, Taluk, Vellore-631051, Tamilnadu** for conducting **B.Ed, B.Ed-AI & M.Ed** courses w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, by the Southern Regional Committee hereby **withdraws recognition of V.S. Isaac College of**

Education, No.126, Attupakkam Village, Arakkonam, Taluk, Vellore-631051, Tamilnadu granted SRC vide order no. F.TN/SEC/154/SRO/NCTE/2004-2005/03 B.Ed. course, order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed.-AI/2008-09/4088 B.Ed.AI course, order no. F.SRO/NCTE/M.Ed. Course,/2006-2007/13911 from the next academic session start after issuance of this order.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order Withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an appeal u/s 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, through “Online mode” available on NCTE’s website <https://ncte.gov.in/Website/Index.aspx> within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filling appeal may be seen on NCTE’s website.
