Withdrawal Order

Whereas, the institution namely Sri. R. Ponnuswamy Naidu Teacher Training Institute, Kakkivadanpatty, Sivakasi Taluk, Virudhunagar District, Tamilnadu was granted recognition for conducting Elementary (D.T.Ed.) course of two year duration with an annual intake of (50 students) from the academic session 2004-2005 vide SRC, NCTE's vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/TN-AI/2004-2005/9309 dt. 13.12.2004.

And Whereas, the institution did not submit its willingness affidavit on as per Regulations 2014.

And Whereas, the institution did not submit any compliance of conditions stipulated in RPRO till date.

And Whereas, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014 a provisional revised recognition order (RPRO) was not issued to the institution.

And Whereas, a letter dt. 28.05.2019 was received from the institution to SRC, NCTE a request for closer of the course along with the documents.

And Whereas, SRC in its 381<sup>st</sup> Meeting held on 26<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup> November 2019 and considered the matter as under:

*"The Committee decided that to withdraw the recognition granted to Sri. R. Ponnuswamy Naidu Teacher Training Institute, Kakkivadanpatty, Sivakasi Taluk, Virudhunagar District, Tamilnadu for conducting D.T.Ed. course under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the request of the institution vide its letter dated 28.05.2019. However, the FDRs towards Reserve Fund and Endowment Fund/ No Objection Certificate (NOC) for encashment of FDRs will be issued by the Regional Director on the submission of the following:*

- (a) NOC from the affiliating body.
- (b) NOC from the staff/faculty.
- (c) Resolution of the management to the effect for closure of the course."

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to Sri. R. Ponnuswamy Naidu Teacher Training Institute, Kakkivadanpatty, Sivakasi Taluk, Virudhunagar District, Tamilnadu from the end of the academic session.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order Withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal u/s 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, through “online mode” available on NCTE’s website [www.ncte-india.org](http://www.ncte-india.org), with 60 days from the date of issue of this order.
