WHEREAS, recognition was granted to the institution namely Reva Institute of Education, 48A, Lakshmaiah Block, 11th Cross, CBI Road Ganganagar, Bangalore-560024, Karnataka run by Bheemanei's Educational System Trust, Bangalore, Karnataka vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/2004-2005/8931 dt. 30.11.2004 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2004-2005.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dt 24.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, thereafter, provisional revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 15.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, a corrigendum vide order no F.SRO/NCTE/APSO2131/B.Ed/KA/2015-16/67239 dated: 16.06.2015 was issued to the institution.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 26.04.2019. The institution did not submit reply to the SCN.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was further considered by the Sub-Committee constituted by the SRC as per decision taken it its 380th meeting. The Sub-Committee of the SRC decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to all such institution where reply to SCN has not been submitted by the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a Final show cause notice was issued to the institution on 15.10.2019. The institution vide letter dated 26.10.2019 submitted a written representation for closure of B.Ed Programme.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 383nd meeting held on 07th to 09th January, 2020 considered the matter and decided as under:-

The Committee decided that to withdraw the recognition granted to Reva Institute of Education, 48A, Lakshmaiah Block, 11th Cross, CBI Road Ganganagar, Bangalore-560024, Karnataka for conducting B.Edcourse under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the request of the institution vide its letter dated 28.12.2019. However, the FDRs towards Reserve Fund and Endowment Fund/ No Objection Certificate (NOC) for encashment of FDRs will be issued by the Regional Director on the submission of the following:

- (a) NOC from the affiliating body.
- (b) NOC from the staff/faculty.
- (c) Resolution of the management to the effect for closure of the course
