WHEREAS, recognition was granted to the institution namely CMM B.Ed College, Mudbi, Basavakalyan -585437, Bidar District, Karnataka run by Sri Laxmi Vidya Vardhaka Sangha, Mudbi-585437, Basavaklyan, Bidar, Karnataka vide order No F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed/2004-2005/8956 date 30.11.2004 for B.Ed Course of one year's duration with an annual intake of one unit(s) of 100 students.

AND WHEREAS, on 31.12.2014 letter was issued to the institution for submission of affidavit expressing adherence to Regulations; 2014. The institution submitted its written representation along with affidavit on 23.06.2015. The Provisional revised order issued to the institution on 01.07.2015 with an intake of 100 students.

AND WHEREAS, on 09.10.2015 a letter is received by this office from the Correspondent Sri Laxmi Vidya Vardhaka Sangha, Bidar District -585 437, Karnataka regarding requestto FDRs withdrawal of interest. A letter issued to the institution on 06.01.2016.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 321st Meeting held on 28th to 30th September, 2016 considered the matter and decided to issue Show Cause Notice. Accordingly as per the decision of SRC a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 14.10.2016. <u>The institution did not submitted its reply to this SCN.</u>

AND WHEREAS, The Committee in its 377th meeting held on 03rd& 04th July, 2019 decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a final show cause notice was issued to the institution on 15.07.2019. <u>The institution did not reply to Final Show</u> <u>Cause Notice till date.</u>

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 382nd meeting held on 26th – 27th November, 2019 considered the matter and decided as under:-

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following deficiency/observations were made:-

The institution was issued Final Show Cause Notice on 15.07.2019. But the institution has not yet submitted its reply till date.

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognitions granted CMM B.Ed College, Mudbi, Basavakalyan -585437, Bidar District, Karnataka for conducting B.Ed courses w.e.f.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of CMM B.Ed College, Mudbi, Basavakalyan -585437, Bidar District, Karnataka run by Sri Laxmi Vidya Vardhaka Sangha, Mudbi-585437, Basavaklyan, Bidar, Karnataka for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (2 units) from the next academic session starts after issuance of this order.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website <u>www.ncte-india.org</u> within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
