WHEREAS, recognition was granted to the institution namely St. Joseph's College of Education, House No. 6, Municipal Colony, Rajahmundry – 533105, East Godavari District, Andhra Pradesh run by Nehru Memorial Ex-Servicemen Educational Society, Rajahmundry, East Godavari District, Andhra Pradesh vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed/2005-2006/5113 Dt. 04.01.2006 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year with an annual intake 100 students from the academic session 2005-2006.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dt. 24.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, thereafter provisional revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 12.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHERAS, as per the decision 322^{nd} Meeting of SRC held on 20^{th} - 21^{st} Oct, 2016 a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 17.11.2016. The institution did not reply to the show cause notice till date.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 381st meeting held on 31st Oct & 01st, Nov, 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue Final SCN u/s 17 of the NCTE Act issued to the institution to submit its representation/reply to the observation noted by the Regional Committee. Accordingly, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 06.12.2019 The institution did not reply to the Final Show Cause Notice.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 383rd Meeting held on 7th, 8th and 9th January 2020 considered the matter and decided as under:-

- (i) The Management of the Institution had not submitted required documents in response to Show Cause Notice (SCN) issued to the Institution on 17.11.2016. Another opportunity was given to the institution by serving a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN) dated 06.12.2019. The institution did not submitted reply/representation in response to Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN).
- (ii) The Dean, Adikavi Nannaya University, Andhra Pradesh vide letter No. No.ANUR/CDC/Edu./NCTE/Information/2019-20/01 dated 19.11.2019, has informed that the University has discontinued the extension of affiliation from the academic year 2015-16 to 2019-20 in respect of the institution St. Joseph's College of Education, House No. 6, Municipal Colony, Rajahmundry 533105, East Godavari District, Andhra Pradesh."

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to St. Joseph's College of Education, House No. 6, Municipal Colony, Rajahmundry – 533105, East Godavari District, Andhra Pradesh for conducting B.Ed. course w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
