WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, Apollo College of Education, Mevaloor Kuppam Village, Sriperumpudur Taluk, Kancheepuram District-631501, Tamilnadu run by Periyasampillai Educational Trust, Aishwarya Complex, 1st Floor, Doraiswamy Road, T.Nagar Chennai, Tamilnadu-17 vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.TN/SRC/SRO/NCTE/2005-2006/6290 dt. 22.11.2005 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution submitted affidavit dt. 23.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, the revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 20.01.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (Two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 381st meeting held on 31st October-01st November 2019 wherein the Committee considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, First Show Cause Notice was issued on 20.12.2019. The institution submitted its reply along with document dt. 02.01.2020.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was finally considered by the SRC in its 384th meeting held on 12th - 13th February 2020 decided as under: -

" The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The Management of the Institution had not submitted required documents in response to Show Cause Notice (SCN) issued to the Institution on 03.05.2019. Another opportunity was given to the institution by serving a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN) dated 12.12.2019. The institution vide letter dated 07.01.2020 submitted its reply/representation in response to Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN). On perusal of the same the Committee found the following defects / shortcomings / deficiencies as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 which are as under:-

1. The institution did not submit the letter issued by the affiliating body regarding approval of faculty members. The institution has only submitted proforma signed by the Registrar, TTEU only in respect of 13 against the requirement of 15 under NCTE regulations.

2. *The institution submitted a copy of building plan but is neither approved nor legible.*
3. *BCC is not in format.*
4. *NEC not submitted.*
5. *The institution submitted a sale deed dt. 2.12.2004 (Survey no. 92, land measuring 1.48 (Hec.) which is different from Sale deeds dt. 28.10.2004 (Survey No. 63/2; land measuring 2.63 Acres) and Sale deed dt. 28.10.2004 (Survey no. 63/2 part; land measuring 2.63 Acres) submitted at the time of grant of recognition.*

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to Apollo College of Education, Mevaloor Kuppam Village, Sriperumpudur Taluk, Kancheepuram District 631501, Tamilnadu for conducting B.Ed. course w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above."

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to Apollo College of Education, Mevaloor Kuppam Village, Sriperumpudur Taluk, Kancheepuram District-631501, Tamilnadu run by Periyasampillai Educational Trust, Aishwarya Complex, 1st Floor, Doraiswamy Road, T.Nagar Chennai, Tamilnadu-17 for running B.Ed course of 2 basic units of 100 students from the end of the academic session. The withdrawal recognition is effective for academic session commences next to issuance of this order.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order Withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal u/s 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org, with 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filling appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
