WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

**WHEREAS**, recognition was granted to the institution namely **Sri Vidya College of Education, Plot No. 166/1, Gandimysamma, Chowrastra, Bowrampet- 500855, Rengareddy District, Andhra Pradesh** run by **Sri Saraswathi Society, Narasapur, Medak District Andhra Pradesh** vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APSO3706/B.Ed/2004-2005/1472 dt. 24.03.2005 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

**AND WHEREAS**, the recognition was granted to the institution on 24.03.2005 for offering B.Ed course with an annual intake of 100 students with a condition that the institution shall shift to its own premises within three years from the date of recognition (in case the course is started in a rented premises).

**AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 178<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 13<sup>th</sup> -14<sup>th</sup> July, 2009 considered the cases of non- shifting of colleges to permanent building and it was decided to issue show cause notice and obtain shifting fees and other documents for causing inspection for shifting. As per the decision of SRC, a letter was issued to the institution on 01.09.2009. The institution did not submit its reply.

**AND WHEREAS**, a letter dated 08.01.2010 was received from the Osmania University on 16.01.2010 recommending shifting of college premises from academic year 2009-10 on the basis of inspection conducted by them at the request of the institution. On 31.12.2014, letters were issued to all existing institutions regarding notification of new Regulations 2014 and seeking consent on their willingness for fulfilling the revised norms and standards before 31.10.2015.

**AND WHEREAS**, the institution submitted its willingness affidavit on 03.02.2015 as regulations 2014. Accordingly, revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 11.05.2015 for two basic units of 50 students each, with a condition that the institution has not shifted to its own premises.

**AND WHEREAS**, the institution submitted its written representation dated nil on 03.12.2015 along with DD of Rs 1,50,000/- bearing no.042728 dated 06.11.2015. The documents submitted by the institution were processed and placed before SRC in its 315<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 17<sup>th</sup> to 18<sup>th</sup> June 2016. The committee considered the matter and decided as follows;

- 1.This is a case of shifting without NCTE approval. The title deed is in order.
- 2.EC and LUC are in order.
- 3.BP & BCC are not approved by competent authority. According to BP, built-up area is inadequate; but, according to BCC it is adequate.
- 4.Original FDRs and latest Faculty list are not given.
- 5.Processing Fee has been paid in full.
- 6.Cause Inspection for shifting B.Ed (2 units).

7. Ask VT to collect all relevant documents; and, check in particular adequacy of built-up area to accommodate B.Ed (2 units) of the 2014 pattern ie., total intake of (100+100)=200.

**AND WHEREAS**, as per the decision of SRC, the inspection intimation was sent to institution on 03.08.2016. The inspection of the institution was conducted on 22.08.2016 and the VT report received in the office on 26.08.2016. The SRC in its 321<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 28<sup>th</sup> & 29<sup>th</sup> September, 2016 considered the VT report and decided to issue show cause notice for the following grounds;

1. BP not approved.
2. BCC not approved.
3. Original FDRs and latest faculty list not given.
4. Built up area is inadequate.

**AND WHEREAS**, as per the decision of SRC, a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 25.10.2016. The institution did not reply to the show cause notice till date. Therefore, a Final Show Cause Notice dated 11.10.2019 was issued to the Institution. The institution did not reply to the Final Show Cause Notice till date. The SRC in its 382<sup>nd</sup> meeting held on 26<sup>th</sup> – 27<sup>th</sup> November, 2019 considered the matter and decided as under:-

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following deficiency/observations were made:-

The institution was issued Final Show Cause Notice on 11.10.2019. But the institution has not yet submitted its reply till date.

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognitions** granted to **Sri Vidya College of Education, Plot No.166/1, Gandimysamma, Chowrastha, Bowrampet- 500855, Rangareddy District, Telangana** for conducting B.Ed courses w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of **Sri Vidya College of Education, Plot No. 166/1, Gandimysamma, Chowrastha, Bowrampet- 500855, Rangareddy District, Telangana** run by **Sri Saraswathi Society, Narasapur, Medak District Telangana** for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (2 units) from the next academic session starts after issuance of this order.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

**“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”**

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website [www.ncte-india.org](http://www.ncte-india.org) within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
