WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely Sri Rajarajeshwari College of Education, No.36, A&B, Town Station Road, Thiruchirappalli District Tamilnadu run by Sri Maruti Educational Trust, Tiruchirappalli District Tamilnadu vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/2006-2007 / 18576 dt. 06.03.2008 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution submitted affidavit dt. 28.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, the revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 31.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (Two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, as per the decision a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 25.03.2019.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 380<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 18<sup>th</sup> -19<sup>th</sup> September 2019 wherein the Committee considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, Final Show Cause Notice was issued on 28.10.2019.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was finally considered by the SRC in its 384<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup> - 13<sup>th</sup> February 2020 decided as under:-

*"The Management of the Institution had not submitted required documents in response to letter The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -*

- (i) The Management of the Institution had not submitted required documents in response to Show Cause Notice (SCN) issued to the Institution on 25.03.2019. Another opportunity was given to the institution by serving a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN) dated 28.10.2019. **The institution did not submit its reply/representation in response to Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN).**

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to Sri Rajarajeshwari College of Education, No. 36, A&B, Town Station Road, Tiruchirappalli District - 620002, Tamilnadu for conducting B.Ed. course w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned

**NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17 of 1993 of NCTE Regulations the institution namely **Sri Rajarajeshwari College of Education, No.36, A&B, Town Station Road, Thiruchirappalli District Tamilnadu** run by **Sri Maruti Educational Trust, Tiruchirappalli District Tamilnadu**, is hereby withdrawn for conducting **B.Ed** programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students on the grounds mentioned above. The withdrawal of recognition is effective from the academic session commences next to issuance of this order.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order **Withdrawing Recognition** under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal u/s 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, through “online mode” available on NCTE’s website [www.ncte-india.org](http://www.ncte-india.org), with 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filling appeal may be seen on NCTE’s website.
