ORDER

WHEREAS, the institution namely Shanmugha Arts, Science, Technology & Research Academy University (SASTRA), Srinivasa Ramanujan Centre, Thanjavur District – 613402, Tamilnadu was granted recognition vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/M.Ed./2007-2008/19076 dt.28.03.2008 for conducting M.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 25 students. The intake of M.Ed. course was enhanced on the basis of NCTE (amendment) Regulations, 2010 from 25 to 35.

AND WHEREAS, after the promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014 the institution, by a notarized affidavit dated 24.01.2015 consented to come under new Regulations, 2014.

AND WHEREAS, thereafter, a provisional revised recognition orders (RPROs) was issued to the institution on 22.05.2015 for conducting M.Ed. course of two years duration with an intake of 50 students (one unit) with the conditions that the institution shall create additional funds as per Regulations, 2014 and inform Regional Committee with required documents by October 31, 2015.

AND WHEREAS, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance.

AND WHEREAS, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 21.02.2019. The institution has submitted its reply on 18.03.2019.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 379th meeting held on 21st – 22nd August, 2019 considered the matter and decided as under: -

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The Committee perused the file and it is observed that the SASTRA University submitted an affidavit 26.11.2016 stating that they are discontinuing M.Ed programme and accordingly, they have taken out from the list of approved courses run by the university.

Therefore, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to Shanmugha Arts, Science, Technology & Research Academy University (SASTRA), Srinivasa Ramanujan Centre, Thanjavur District – 613402, Tamilnadu for M.Ed course from the academic year 2017-18 onwards.

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby **withdraws recognition of Shanmugha Arts, Science, Technology & Research Academy University (SASTRA), Srinivasa Ramanujan Centre, Thanjavur District - 613402, Tamilnadu** granted SRC vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/M.Ed./2007-2008/9076 dt.28.03.2008 for conducting M.Ed. course of one year' duration with an annual intake of 25 students from the next academic session starts after issuance of this order. The provisional revised recognition orders No.F.SRO/NCTE/APSO4944/M.Ed/TN/2015/65362 dt. 22.5.2015 issued to the institution in respect of M.Ed course of 2 years duration with an annual intake of 50 seats is also hereby withdrawn.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order Withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an appeal u/s 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, through “Online mode” available on NCTE’s website <http://ncte.gov.in> , within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filling appeal may be seen on NCTE’s website.
