WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely Esther College of Education, Nallur, N. Pudupatti Post, Namakkal - 637013 run by Sheela Christian Charitable Trust, 12-3/34, South Car Street, Tharamangalam, Salem, 636502, Tamilnadu on dt. 22.11.2007 for conducting M.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 25 students.

AND WHEREAS, the enhancement of intake of 10 seats from existing 25 to 35 was permitted on 24.08.2010.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution submitted affidavit dt. 19.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, the revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 25.05.2015 for conducting M.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students of 50 students from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, as per the decision a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 19.07.2019.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 380th meeting held on 18th -19th September 2019 wherein the Committee considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, Final Show Cause Notice was issued on 30.10.2019.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was finally considered by the SRC in its 384th meeting held on 12th – 13th February 2020 decided as under:-

(i) The Management of the Institution had not submitted required documents in response to Show Cause Notice (SCN) issued to the Institution on 19.07.2019. Another opportunity was given to the institution by serving a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN) dated 30.10.2019. The institution did not submit its reply/representation in response to Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN).

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to Esther College of Education, Nallur, N. Pudupatti Post, Namakkal – 637013 for conducting M.Ed. course w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17 of 1993 of NCTE Regulations the institution namely Esther College of Education, Nallur, N. Pudupatti Post, Namakkal - 637013 run by Sheela Christian Charitable Trust, 12-3/34, South Car Street, Tharamangalam, Salem, 636502,

Tamilnadu, is hereby withdrawn for conducting M.Ed programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students on the grounds mentioned above. The withdrawal of recognition is effective from the academic session commences next to issuance of this order.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order Withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal u/s 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org, with 60 days from the day of issue of this order. The guidelines for filling appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
