WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely **Ayesha College of Education for Women, Payan Darga Road, Roza (B), Gulbarga District- 585104, Karnataka** run by **Islamia Education Trust, Gulbarga District, Karnataka** vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed/2006-2007/APS05363/12533 dt. 04.10.2007 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dt 02.02.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, a revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 16.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (Two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 369th meeting decided to issue common SCN to all such institutions (one unit or two or more unit cases) asking to submit details regarding additional facilities, additional infrastructure, additional fund, additional staff as per Regulation, 2014. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 11.03.2019. The institution did not submit reply to show cause notice till date.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was further considered by the Sub-Committee constituted by the SRC as per its decision taken in 380th meeting. The Sub-Committee to issue Final Show Cause Notice to all such institution where reply to SCN has not been submitted by the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC final show cause notice was issued to the institution on 14.10.2019. The institution vide letter dated 17.10.2019 submitted its reply to the final show cause notice. The SRC in its 384th meeting held on 12th -13th February, 2020 considered the matter and decided as under:-

The Committee decided that to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **Ayesha College of Education for Women, Payan Darga Road, Roza (B), Gulbarga District Karnataka – 585104** for conducting **B.Ed course** under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the request of the institution vide its letter dated 17.10.2019. However, the FDRs towards Reserve Fund and Endowment Fund/ No Objection Certificate (NOC) for encashment of FDRs will be issued by the Regional Director on the submission of the following:

- NOC from the affiliating body.
- NOC from the staff/faculty.
- Resolution of the management to the effect for closure of the course

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **Moulana Azad B.Ed College, Radhakrishna Nagar, Teachers Layout, Mysore-5700011, Karnataka** for conducting

B.Ed course w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of **Ayesha College of Education for Women, Payan Darga Road, Roza (B), Gulbarga District- 585104, Karnataka** run by **Islamia Education Trust, Gulbarga District-585104, Karnataka** for conducting **B.Ed.** programme of two year duration with an annual intake of 100 students (2 units) from the next academic session starts after issuance of this order.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
