WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

WHEREAS, recognition was granted to the institution namely **Siddhartha College of Education, No. 1-6-68, Paramareddy Colony, Pallburgh, Narayanpet-509210, Mahabubnagar District, Andhra Pradesh** run by **Vidya Bharathi Educational Society, Mahabubnagar, Andhra Pradesh** was granted recognition for offering **B.Ed** course vide order no. **F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed/2007-2008/12744** dated **09.10.2007** with condition that the institution shall shift to its own premises within three years from the date of recognition (In case the course is started in rented premises).

AND WHEREAS, on **31.12.2014**, letters were issued to all existing institutions regarding notification of new Regulations 2014 seeking consent on their willingness for fulfilling the revised norms and standards before **31.10.2015**.

AND WHEREAS, on **22.01.2015**, the institution has submitted the affidavit for offering **B.Ed** course with an intake before **31.10.2015**.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its **276th** meeting held on **7th-9th** January, 2015 decided to issue provisional recognition orders to the existing institutions and the committee also decided to maintain a check list of such cases for verification in **October/November** and for causing inspection.

AND WHEREAS, as per the Regulation 2014 a revised recognition order was issued to the institution on **11.05.2015** for annual intake of **100** students with a condition that the institution has not shifted to its own premises as stipulated in its Formal Recognition Order dated **09.10.2007**.

AND WHEREAS, the institution has submitted two letters on **04.08.2015** & **31.10.2015** along with relevant documents and DD of Rs. **1, 50,000/-** bearing No. **778507** as shifting fee. The SRC in its **315th** meeting held on **17th-18th** June, 2016, the committee considered the matter and decided as under;

1. They have applied for permission to shift.
2. They have also paid the inspection fee in full.
3. But, they have not given any documents; not even the title deed.
4. Issue Show Cause Notice for documents.

AND WHEREAS, as per the decision of SRC, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on **12.07.2016**. The institution submitted its reply on **08.08.2016** and placed before SRC in its **322nd** meeting held on **20th & 21st** October, 2016 and decided to issue show cause notice. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a show cause notice was issued to the institution on **16.11.2016**. **The institution did not reply to the show cause notice till date.**

AND WHEREAS, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 09.10.2019. The institution did not reply to the Final Show Cause Notice till date. The SRC in its 382nd meeting held on 26th – 27th November, 2019 considered the matter and decided as under:-

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following deficiency/observations were made:-

The institution was issued Final Show Cause Notice on 09.10.2019. But the institution has not yet submitted its reply till date.

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognitions granted to Siddartha College of Education, No. 1-6-68, Paramareddy Colony, Pallburgh, Narayanpet-509210, Mahabubnagar District, Telangana for conducting B.Ed courses w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of **Siddartha College of Education, No. 1-6-68, Paramareddy Colony, Pallburgh, Narayanpet-509210, Mahabubnagar District, Telangana** run by **Vidya Bharathi Educational Society, Mahabubnagar, Telangana** for conducting **B.Ed.** programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (2 units) from the next academic session starts after issuance of this order.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through “online mode” available on NCTE’s website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE’s website.
