WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely **Sahil College of Education, Shanti Nikethan Educational Campus, Chidri Road, Bidar Dist-585403, Karnataka** run by **Bidar Vidya Kendra, Bidar- 585403, Karnataka** vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APS07378/B.Ed/2006-2007/6188 dt. 30.08.2007 for conducting B.Ed course of two-years duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dt. 10.02.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A provisional revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 16.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, as per the decision of 369th Meeting of SRC held on 28.01.2019 a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 05.02.2019. **The institution did not reply to the show cause notice till date.**

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in 380th meeting the Sub-Committee decided to issue Show Cause Notice to all such institution where reply to SCN has not been submitted by the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a final show cause notice was issued to the institution on 14.10.2019. **The institution did not submit the reply to the Show Cause Notice.**

"It is also pertinent to mention here that the Registrar, Gulbarga University, Karnataka vide letter No. SI.No.GUK/ACA?B.Ed/2019-20/1231 dated 06.11.2019, has informed that the University has discontinued the extension of affiliation from the academic year 2016-2017 in respect of the institution Sahil College of Education, Shanti Nikethan Educational Campus, Chidri Road, Bidar Dist- 585403, Karnataka."

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 383rd Meeting held on 7th to 9th January 2020 considered the matter and decided as under:-

The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

- (i) The Management of the Institution had not submitted required documents in response to Show Cause Notice (SCN) issued to the Institution on 05.02.2019.

- (ii) *The Registrar, Gulbarga University, Karnataka vide letter No. Sl.No.GUK/ACA?B.Ed/2019-20/1231 dated 06.11.2019, has informed that the University has discontinued the extension of affiliation from the academic year 2016-2017 in respect of the institution Sahil College of Education, Shanti Nikethan Educational Campus, Chidri Road, Bidar Dist- 585403, Karnataka."*

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **Sahil College of Education, Shanti Nikethan Educational Campus, Chidri Road, Bidar Dist-585403, Karnataka** for conducting B.Ed. course w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of **Sahil College of Education, Shanti Nikethan Educational Campus, Chidri Road, Bidar Dist-585403, Karnataka** run by **Bidar Vidya Kendra, Bidar- 585403, Karnataka** for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (2 units) from the next academic session starts after issuance of this order.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
