WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, **Annai India College of Education, Bommidi Post, Dharmapuri-635301, Tamilnadu** run by **Annai India Educational Trust, Dharmapuri-635301, Tamilnadu** vide SRC (NCTE) order no. **F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed/2006-2007/14176 dt. 06.11.2007** for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution submitted affidavit dt. 28.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, the revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on **05.05.2015** for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (Two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, as per the decision a Show Cause notice was issued to the institution on 29.07.2019.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 382nd meeting held on 26th-27th November 2019 wherein the Committee considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, First Show Cause Notice was issued on 20.12.2019. The institution submitted its reply along with document dt. 09.12.2020. The institution submitted in its reply along with the documents dt: 07.01.2020

AND WHEREAS, the matter was finally considered by the SRC in its 384th meeting held on 12th - 13th February 2020 decided as under: -

The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The Management of the Institution had not submitted required documents in response to letter issued to the Institution on 29.07.2019. Another opportunity was given to the institution by serving a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN) dated 09.12.2019. The institution vide letter dated 07.01.2020 submitted its reply/representation in response to Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN). On perusal of the same the Committee found the following defects / shortcomings / deficiencies as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 which are as under:-

1. The institute has submitted approval of University only in respect of 8 faculty against the requirement of 1 + 15 under NCTE Regulations.
2. Total converted area has not been mentioned in the LUC and the LUC is not in proper format of State Government.

3. The institute submitted only 1 + 7 faculty against the requirement 1 + 15 under NCTE Regulations.
4. The institute submitted only Form 'A' and not submitted original copy of FDRs of Rs.12 lakhs as per NCTE Regulations.
5. The total land area mentioned in Building Plan do not match with other documents.
6. As per "Account of annual farmer capture cultivation" signed by Zonal Deputy Tahsildar (Originally submitted by the institute) the school is being run on the land and the institute did not submit earmarked Building Plan.

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to Annai India College of Education, Bommidi Post, Dharmapuri-635301, Tamilnadu for conducting B.Ed course w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to Annai India College of Education, Bommidi Post, Dharmapuri-635301, Tamilnadu run by Annai India Educational Trust, Dharmapuri-635301, Tamilnadu for running B.Ed course of 2 basic units of 100 students from the end of the academic session. The withdrawal recognition is effective for academic session commences next to issuance of this order.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order Withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal u/s 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org, with 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filling appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
