Withdrawal Order

Whereas, the institution namely **Girivasan College of Education, No. 2/969, AVSK Bharath Building, R.S. West, Sakthi Colony, Nellinagar, Kumaraswamy Post, Dharmapuri, Tamilnadu-636703** was granted recognition vide SRC, NCTE order No. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2006-2007/15285 dt. 26.11.2007 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2006-2007.

And Whereas, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dt. 28.01.2015 for its willingness of two units in B.Ed. course and adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

And Whereas, provisional revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 01.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 for two basic units of 50 students from the academic session 2015-2016 with a condition to maintain.

And Whereas, the institution submitted compliance against RPRO issued in respect of B.Ed. course vide letter dt. 03.11.2015.

And Whereas, in the meantime, in 314th meeting held on 27th & 28th May 2016 the SRC taken a general decision to cause inspection of such cases.

And Whereas, as per the decision of SRC, a letter for inspection was sent on 14.06.2016, but inspection was not conducted.

And Whereas, the matter is placed on SRC in its 374th meeting held on 09th & 10th April 2019 and the Committee decided to issued Show Cause Notice under section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 for submission of reply on the following grounds: -

1. *"The faculty is not approved by the affiliating body.*
2. *The FDRs as required under NCTE Regulations, 2014 towards Endowment Fund and Reserve Fund not submitted.*
3. *The Building plan submitted by the institution is not legible.*
4. *BCC has not been submitted in proper format.*
5. *NEC submitted but the same is expired on 21.12.2012.*
6. *Certified copy of land documents issued by the competent authority along with notarized English translation have not been submitted."*

Accordingly, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on dt. 12.04.2019.

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Therefore, it has been observed that the institution did not submit any compliance of Final Show Cause Notice (SCN) dt. 12.04.2019 till date.

The matter was placed before SRC in its 382nd meeting held on 26th – 27th November 2019 and the committee was decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. The following is highlighted:

- **The institute did not submit and reply of SCN dt. 12.04.2019 hence the matter was placed before SRC.**
- **The deficiencies of SCN dt. 12.04.2019 do not match with the deficiencies cited in minutes.**

And Whereas, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution dt.09.12.2019. The institution submitted its reply along with documents dt.02.01.2020.

And Whereas, the SRC in its 384th meeting held on 12th & 13th February 2020 and considered the matter as under:

“The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The Management of the Institution had not submitted required documents in response to letter issued to the Institution on 12.04.2019. Another opportunity was given to the institution by serving a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN) dated 09.12.2019. The institution vide letter dated 02.01.2020 submitted its reply/representation in response to Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN). On perusal of the same the Committee found the following defects / shortcomings / deficiencies as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 which are as under: -


1. **The institute did not submit a certified copy of land documents.**
2. **The LUC cannot be relied upon on the face of deficiency in NEC.**
3. **The NEC shows the nature of land as “House Site”.**
4. **The Multipurpose Hall size is less than the requirement of NCTE Regulations.**
5. **The BCC is not in proper prescribed format.**
6. **The institute submitted only 1 + 5 faculty against the requirement 1 + 15 under NCTE Regulations.**
7. **A photocopy of FDRs submitted only Rs.5 lakhs instead of original against the requirement of 12 Lakhs and Form ‘A’ also not submitted.**
8. **Domain name of the website being run by the institution not provided.**
9. **The institute did not submit documents of Managing Trust/ Society.**

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **Girivasan College of Education, No. 2/969, AVSK Bharath Building, R.S. West, Sakthi Colony, Nellinagar, Kumaraswamy Post, Dharmapuri, Tamilnadu-636703** for conducting **B.Ed. course w.e.f. the next academic session** under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.”

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order Withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal u/s 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, through “online mode” available on NCTE’s website www.ncte-india.org, with 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filling appeal may be seen on NCTE’s website.
