WHEREAS, recognition was granted to the institution namely RJC College of Education, No. 1-7-59, Trunk Road, Khammam District, Telangana run by Swarna Bharathi Educational Society, Khammam District, Telangana vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed/2008-2009/3830 dt. 13.08.2008 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2008-2009.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dt 21.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, a Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on 06.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (Two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, the FDRs in original were returned to the institution vide letter dt. 25.06.2015. The SRC in its 363rd meeting held on 17th – 19th September, 2018 considered the matter and decided as under:

1. The applicant-institution was running a B.Ed. programme.

2. After notification of the 2014 Regulations, because of the increase in the courseperiod from 1 to 2 years, because of increased requirements of facilities (especially of built-up area and faculty), they were given a RPRO and required to furnish documents for verification of satisfaction of the new norms/ standards.

3. The applicant in this case has not adequately responded. Therefore, issue a Show

Cause Notice for withdrawal of recognition.

4. If they do not respond satisfactorily, we can proceed to withdraw the recognition given.

5. If they respond satisfactorily, then, we will have to cause a VT Inspection to verify the

veracity of the claims made.

6.1 It upon inspection, all claims are verified to be valid, we can issue a Regular Recognition Order (RRO) under the 2014 Regulations. It is to be recognized that RPROs cannot continue indefinitely, as they are ipso facto 'provisional'.

6.2 If upon inspection, the claims are not fully validated, then, we will have to refer the case to NCTE (HQ) for necessary action under section 13 since, according to the Supreme Court decision, we cannot proceed with action for de-recognition based on inspection under section 47.

6.3 We had discussed this issue in detail in 351st SRC meeting held on 28th & 29th December 2017 when we authorized the RD to proceed with action in RPRO cases since SRC was fully engaged in clearing new application cases before the Supreme Court prescribed dateline for issue of FRs.

7. Please put up all such cases together for a common order for similar action.

AND WHEREAS, as per the decision of SRC a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 17.10.2018. The institution did not submitted reply to the show cause notice till date. The SRC in its 377th meeting held on 03rd & 04th July, 2019 considered the matter and decided as under;

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

1. The institution has not submitted a copy of approved building plan. The institution is required to submit a attested/notarised copy of the approved Building Plan (if institution is running more than one Teacher Education programme, it shall be required to submit an exclusive earmarked building plan for each of the recognised Teacher Education programme)

2. The institution has not submitted a copy of Building Completion Certificate. The Institution is required to submit an attested/notarised copy of Building

Completion Certificate issued by the competent authority.

3. The institution has not submitted Staff list as per the prescribed Format duly approved by Registrar of the affiliating body. The institution is required to submit Staff list duly approved by the Registrar of the affiliating body as per the prescribed Format. (In case the institution is running more than one teacher education programme, it is required to submit staff list duly approved by the Affiliating body for each of the recognised teacher education programme being run by the Institution.)

4. The institution has not submitted original FDRs to the SRC, NCTE The institution is required to submit a "Form A" issued by the respective Bank Manger towards creation of FDR of Rs.7 lakh and 5 lakh, totalling Rs.12 lakh towards Endowment Fund & Reserve Fund into joint account for a duration of 5

years alogwith a copy of the FDRs

Therefore, the Committee decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 before withdrawal of the recognition on the grounds mentioned above to the institution. The institution is required to submit the documents within 21 days from the date of issue of Final Show Cause Notice.

AND WHEREAS, as per the decision of SRC a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 17.07.2019. The institution vide letter dated 25.07.2019 submitted its reply to the Final Show Cause Notice. The SRC in its 380th meeting held on 18th – 19th September, 2019 considered the matter and decided as under;

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The Committee decided that to withdraw the recognition granted to RJC College of Education, No. 1-7-59, Trunk Road, Khammam District, Telangana for conducting B.Ed. course under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the request of the institution vide its letter dated 25.07.2019. However, the FDRs towards Reserve Fund and Endowment Fund/ No Objection Certificate (NOC) for encashment of FDRs will be issued by the Regional Director on the submission of the following:

- (a) NOC from the affiliating body.
- (b) NOC from the staff/faculty.
- (c) Resolution of the management to the effect for closure of the course.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of RJC College of Education, No. 1-7-59, Trunk Road, Khammam District, Telangana run by Swarna Bharathi Educational Society, Khammam District, Telangana for conducting B.Ed programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (2 units) on the grounds mentioned above.

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
