WHEREAS, recognition was granted to the institution namely Sri Chakra College Education Sy. no. 209, Sheriguda Village, Ibrahimpatnam Mandal, H.D.M. A. Rangareddy, Andhra Pradesh run by Srinivasa Educational Society, Sy. No. 209, Sheriguda Village, Ibrahimapatnam Mandal, H.M.D.A. Rangareddy District, Pin-501510 Andhra Pradesh vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.No.APSO8574/B.Ed/AP/2012/45744 dt. 03.09.2012 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2012-2013.

AND WHEREAS, a letter dated 08.04.2014 was received from the Principal, Sri Chakra College of Education, Sheriguda, IBPTM, Rangareddy District, HMDA, Andhra Pradesh on 07.05.2014. The SRC in its 269th meeting held during 1-2 July, 2014 considered the reply and other relevant document and decided to issue show cause notice for the following:

• Withdrawal of recognition - Staff list is not as per NCTE norms and it is not approved by the affiliating authority.

AND WHEREAS, as per the decision of SRC, a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 07.08.2014. The institution submitted reply on 27.08.2014. The SRC in its 273rd meeting held during 29th& 30th September, 2014 considered the reply along with relevant documents of the institution and decided to withdraw recognition for the following reasons:-

• Lecturers (Foundation, Art Education, and Physical Education) are not there. The staff list is not also in the prescribed form.

AND WHEREAS, as per the decision of SRC, withdrawal order issued to the institution on 19.11.2014. Aggrieved by the withdrawal order of SRC, the institution preferred an appeal to NCTE-Hqrs. NCTE, Hqrs. vide order. F.No. 89-02/2015 Appeal/2nd Meeting -2015 dated 05.05.2015 stating that.

"Sh. Mohd. TousifDirector, Sri Chakra College of Education, Rangareddy Telangana Presented the case of the appellant institution on 14.04.2015. In the appeal and during personal presentation it was submitted that "they have submitted to the SRC the Copies of staff approval selected Committee for the academic years 2012-13 and 2013-14 together with the letters issued by the Deputy Registrar, Osmania University with their letter dated 20.08.2014. The so-called non-submission of the approved list in the prescribed format in neither a deficiency nor any contravention so as to fall within the ambit of Section 17 of the Act".

The Committee noted that the Show Cause Notice issued to the appellant on 07.08.2014 mentioned that staff list submitted by the institution is not as per NCTE norms and it is not approved by the affiliating body. The withdrawal order dt.19.11.2014 is on different grounds and which were not included in the Show Cause Notice. In the circumstances the committee concluded that the matter deserved to be remanded to the SRC with a direction

to issue a show cause notice to the appellant communicating the grounds mentioned in the withdrawal order and take further action as per the Regulations . In the meantime the withdrawal order will remain in abeyance.

The Council hereby remands back the case of Sri Chakra College of Education, Rangareddy, Telangana to the SRC,NCTE, for necessary action as indicated above."

AND WHEREAS, a letter dated 21.04.2015 and 15.05.2015 received by this office from the Principal. The SRC in its 287th meeting held on 20th May 2016, considered the appeal remand back case and decided to "Restore Recognition." Accordingly, Restored Recognition order was issued on 29.05.2015. The institution submitted its written representation along with relevant documents on 05.11.2015. The SRC its 314th meeting held on 27th and 28thMay, 2016 the committee decided as under:

For cases of B.Ed (2 Units) in the existing institution, where RPRO, has been issued, we have to cause inspection to check adherence to the 2014 Regulations. This action will have to be completed by July 2016 so that revised Formal Recognition can be issued w.e.f. 2016-17 to enable them to make admission in time.

Action to check the documents in these cases (about 1885 in number) will take time. Instead of Waiting for that action to be completed for placing them before the SRC, to save time, VT Inspections can straightaway be ordered. VT Inspection Report can be considered along with examination of the documents.

Regional Director is authorised to initiate action accordingly. The institution concerned may be alerted about such action so that they will be prepared to receive the Visiting Teams. They may also be advised to keep in readiness latest approved Faculty Lists for Submission to the VTs.

AND WHEREAS, inspection intimation was sent to the institution on 14.06.2015. Inspection of the institution was conducted on 09.10.2016 & 10.10.2016 and VT report along with documents and CD received on13.10.2016. The SRC in its 323rd meeting held on 16th& 18thNovember, 2016 considered the VT report and decided to issue show cause notice for the following grounds;

- 1. BP is not approved by competent authority.
- 2. Original FDRs not given.
- 3. Faculty list approved by the affiliating body not given.

AND WHEREAS, as per the decision of SRC, a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 29.11.2016. The institution did not reply to the show cause notice till date. A Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 11.10.2019. The institution did not reply to the Final Show Cause Notice till date. The SRC in its 382nd meeting held on 26th – 27th November, 2019 considered the matter and decided as under:-

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following deficiency/observations were made:-

The institution was issued Final Show Cause Notice on 11.10.2019. But the institution has not yet submitted its reply till date.

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognitions granted to Srinivasa Educational Society, Sy. No. 209, Sheriguda Village, Ibrahimapatnam Mandal,

H.M.D.A. Rangareddy District, Pin-501510, Telangana for conducting B.Ed courses w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of Sri Chakra College Education Sy. No. 209, Sheriguda Village, Ibrahimpatnam Mandal, H.D.M A. Rangareddy, Telangana run by Srinivasa Educational Society, Sy. No. 209, Sheriguda Village, Ibrahimapatnam Mandal, H.M.D.A. Rangareddy District, Pin-501510, Telangana for conducting B.Ed.programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (2 units) from the next academic session starts after issuance of this order.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
