WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, S.N.S College of Education, No. 487, Thudiyalur-Sarvanampatti Road, Coimbatore, Tamilnadu-641006 run by Sri S.N.S Charitable Trust, 563, donboscopuram, Vellakinar Post, Coimbatore District-641029, Tamilnadu vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed/2006-2007/15317 dt: 28.11.2007 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution submitted affidavit dt. 14.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, the revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 30.04.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (Two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 377th meeting held on 03rd & 04th July, 2019 wherein the Committee considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, Final Show Cause Notice was issued on 12.07.2019.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was finally considered by the SRC in its 384th meeting held on 12th - 13th February 2020 decided as under: -

"The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The Management of the Institution had not submitted required documents in response to Show Cause Notice (SCN) issued to the Institution on 09.02.2019. Another opportunity was given to the institution by serving a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN) dated 12.07.2019. The institution vide letter dated 13.07.2019 submitted its reply/representation in response to Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN). On perusal of the same the Committee found the following defects / shortcomings / deficiencies as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 which are as under: -

1. *The institute did not submit, originally certified copy of Land documents.*
2. *The building plan is neither approved nor legible.*
3. *The site plan is neither approved by the Coimbatore, Local Planning Authority nor legible.*
4. *The institution has submitted xerox copy of NEC in regional language.*
5. *The institute did not submit the documents of society/trust etc.*
6. *The land has been leased from private person to trust vide lease deed dt. 24.01.2007 for 51 years. The institute had submitted a certificate of land dt. 09.07.2015 vide which it is certified that the land is owned by S. Rajalakshmi whereas the LUC submitted by the institute shows that the*

land is owned by the Trust. These both documents are contrary to each other.

7. *The size of classrooms, Hall etc, are less than the requirement of NCTE Regulations.*

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to Dr. S.N.S College of Education, No. 487, Thudiyalur - Sarvanampatti Road, Coimbatore, Tamilnadu-641006 for conducting B.Ed course w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to S.N.S College of Education, No. 487, Thudiyalur-Sarvanampatti Road, Coimbatore, Tamilnadu-641006 run by Sri S.N.S Charitable Trust, 563, donboscopuram, Vellakinar Post, Coimbatore District-641029, Tamilnadu for running B.Ed course of 2 basic units of 100 students from the end of the academic session. The withdrawal recognition is effective for academic session commences next to issuance of this order.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order Withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal u/s 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, through “online mode” available on NCTE’s website www.ncte-india.org, with 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filling appeal may be seen on NCTE’s website.
