ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution, namely **Vickram Teacher Training College, Sreenivasa Gardens, Madurai Sivagangai Road, Enathi – 630561, Sivagangai District, Tamil Nadu** run by **Srinivas Trust, No – 7, Commanding Officers Second Lane, West Masi Street, Madurai District – 625001, Tamil Nadu** for conducting **M.Ed. course** of one year duration with an intake of **25 students** on **08.08.2008**.

AND WHEREAS, the enhancement of intake of 10 seats from existing 25 to 35 is permitted to **Vickram Teacher Training College, Sreenivasa Gardens, Madurai Sivagangai Road, Enathi – 630561, Sivagangai District, Tamil Nadu** for **M.Ed Course** on **24.08.2010** with effect from the session **2010-2011**.

AND WHEREAS, after promulgation of **NCTE Regulations, 2014**, the institution by a notarized affidavit dated **20.01.2015** consented to come under new Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, thereafter, the Southern Regional Committee (NCTE) issued the revised provisional recognition order dt. **22.05.2015** to **Vickram College Of Education, Sreenivasa Gardens, Enathi Village, Madurai Sivagangai Road, Sivagangai District – 630561, Tamil Nadu** for conducting **M.Ed. course** of two years duration with an annual intake of **50 students [One basic unit of 50 students]** from the academic session **2015-2016** subject to fulfilment of conditions mentioned therein.

AND WHEREAS, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its **369th** meeting held on **28.01.2019** and the committee decided that **Show Cause Notice** be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance.

AND WHEREAS, a **Show Cause Notice** was issued to the institution on **18.02.2019**. The institution has submitted its reply on **02.03.2019** in respect of **SCN** issued above.

And whereas, the SRC in its **379th** meeting held on **21st – 22nd August, 2019** considered the matter and decided as under: -

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, **NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines** issued by **NCTE** from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The Committee noted that the institution vide letter dated **22.2.2019** has requested for withdrawal of recognition for **M.Ed. programme**. Therefore, the Committee decided that to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **Vickram Teacher Training College, Sreenivasa Gardens, Madurai Sivagangai Road, Enathi – 630561, Sivagangai District, Tamilnadu** for conducting **M.Ed. course** w.e.f. the next academic session under clause **17(1)** of **NCTE Act, 1993** on the request of the institution. However, the **Reserve Fund and Endowment Fund** will be refunded by the **Regional Director** on the submission of the following:


- NOC from the affiliating body.
- NOC from the staff/faculty.
- Resolution of the management to the effect for closure of the course

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, by the Southern Regional Committee hereby **withdraws recognition of Vickram Teacher Training College, Sreenivasa Gardens, Madurai Sivagangai Road, Enathi – 630561, Sivagangai District, Tamil Nadugranted SRC vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/M.Ed./2008-2009/3620 dt.08.08.2008 for conducting M.Ed. course from the next academic session starts after issuance of this order. Further the provisional recognition order of recognition No.F.SRO/NCTE/APSO8862/M.Ed/TN/2015/65345dt. 22/05/2015 is also withdrawn.**

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order Withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an appeal u/s 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, through “Online mode” available on NCTE’s website <http://ncte.gov.in> within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. 
