WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, Recognition was granted to the institution namely **Rishi College of Education, Bairagiguda Village, Rajendranagar Mandal, RangareddyDist, Telangana** run by **Karnataka Hyderabad Educational Society, Hyderabad, Telangana** vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed/2007-2008/18745 Dt. 14.03.2008 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year with an annual intake 100 students from the academic session 2006-2007.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dt.18.05.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, thereafter, provisional revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 26.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, SRC in its 363rd Meeting held on 17th and 19th September, 2018 decided to issue Show Cause Notice as per the decision of SRC a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 16.10.2018. **The institution did not submit the reply to the Show Cause Notice till date.**

AND WHEREAS, SRC in 381th meeting decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to all such institution where reply to SCN has not been submitted by the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a final show cause notice was issued to the institution on 19.11.2019. **The institution did not submit the reply to the Final Show Cause Notice.**

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 383rd Meeting held on 7th, 8th and 9th January 2020 considered the matter and decided as under:-

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:

- (i) The Management of the Institution had not submitted required documents in response to Show Cause Notice (SCN) issued to the Institution on 16.10.2018. Another opportunity was given to the institution by serving a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN) dated 19.11.2019. **The institution did not submit its reply/representation in response to Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN).**
- (ii) The Registrar, Osmania University, Hyderabad vide letter No. 1554-MR/H/B.Ed/2019-2020/Acad/IV-2 dated 11.12.2019, It is further informed that the University based on the decision of the Executive Council at its 149th meeting held on 20.06.2018 has disaffiliated the B.Ed College from the academic year 2018-19 for violating NCTE/University norms, by not running the college in the sanctioned

premises. The students on rolls were transferred to other colleges to continue their further studies.”

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **Rishi College of Education, Bairagiguda Village, Rajendranagar Mandal, RangareddyDist, Telangana** for conducting **B.Ed.** course w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through “online mode” available on NCTE’s website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE’s website.
