WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely Holy Angels College of Education for Women, S.F. 205, Jadayampalayam, Mettupalayam, Coimbatore-641302, Tamil Nadu run by Holy Angles Trust, No. 8/62, Jadayampalayam, Mettupalayam, Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu 641302 on dt. 05.01.2010 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution submitted affidavit dt. 13.02.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, the revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 31.03.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (Two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, the institution has requested for reduction of intake from 2 units to 1 unit vide letter dt. 20.04.2017. The SRC in its 340th meeting considered the matter and decided to permit 1 unit of B.Ed. Accordingly, an order was issued for running B.Ed with 1 unit of 50 students only on 11.09.2017 with a condition to submit the compliance as stipulated in the order. The institution has submitted reply on 19.03.2019.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 381st meeting held wherein the Committee considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, Final Show Cause Notice was issued on 06.11.2019.

AND WHEREAS, the institution has submitted its reply on 29.11.2019 in respect of Final Show Cause Notice.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was finally considered by the SRC in its 384th meeting held on 12th – 13th February 2020 decided as under:-

The Management of the Institution had not submitted required documents in response to letter issued to the Institution on 12.04.2019. Another opportunity was given to the institution by serving a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN) dated 09.12.2019. The institution vide letter dated 02.01.2020 submitted its reply/representation in response to Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN). On perusal of the same the Committee found the following defects / shortcomings / deficiencies as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 which are as under :-

1. The institute did not submit a certified copy of land documents.
2. The LUC can not be relied upon on the face of deficiency in NEC.
3. The NEC shows the nature of land as "House Site".

4. *The Multipurpose Hall size is less than the requirement of NCTE Regulations.*
5. *The BCC is not in proper prescribed format.*
6. *The institute submitted only 1 + 5 faculty against the requirement 1 + 15 under NCTE Regulations.*
7. *A photocopy of FDRs submitted only Rs.5 lakhs instead of original against the requirement of 12 Lakhs and Form 'A' also not submitted.*
8. *Domain name of the website being run by the institution not provided.*
9. *The institute did not submit documents of Managing Trust/ Society.*

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to Holy Angels College of Education for Women, S.F. 205, Jadayampalayam, Mettupalayam, Coimbatore-641302, Tamil Nadu for conducting B.Ed course w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17 of 1993 of NCTE Regulations the institution namely **Holy Angels College of Education for Women, S.F. 205, Jadayampalayam, Mettupalayam, Coimbatore-641302, Tamil Nadu** run by **Holy Angles Trust, No. 8/62, Jadayampalayam, Mettupalayam, Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu 641302**, is hereby withdrawn for conducting B.Ed programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students on the grounds mentioned above. The withdrawal of recognition is effective from the academic session commences next to issuance of this order.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order Withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal u/s 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, through “online mode” available on NCTE’s website www.ncte-india.org, with 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filling appeal may be seen on NCTE’s website.
