WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely Sidhartha B.Ed College, House No.8, Mig-II, Housing Board Colony, Bhalki, Bidar-585328, Karnataka run by Panchasheela Educationa Trust, House No.8, Mig-II Housing Board Colony, Bhalki, Bidar Karnataka vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRC/NCTE/2009/B.Ed/RO/14865 dt. 30.07.2007 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

**AND WHEREAS,** on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dt 30.07.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A provisional revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 15.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

**AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 369<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 28.01.2019 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 25.04.2019. The institution did not submitted reply to the SCN.

AND WHEREAS, the Sub-Committee of the SRC in 380<sup>th</sup> meeting decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to all such institution where reply to SCN has not been submitted by the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 15.10.2019. The institution vide letter dated 08.11.2019 submitted its reply to the Final Show Cause Notice. The SRC in its 383<sup>rd</sup> Meeting held on 7<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> January 2020 considered the matter and decided as under:-

The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

(i) The institution has not submitted a copy of site plan

(ii) The institution has not submitted latest staff list approved by the affiliating University as per the prescribed format.

(iii) FDRs for Endowment Fund & Reserve Fund not submitted

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to Siddhartha B.Ed College, Karnataka for conducting B.Ed. course w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of Sidhartha B.Ed College, House No.8, Mig-II, Housing Board Colony, Bhalki, Bidar-585328, Karnataka run by Panchasheela

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website <a href="https://www.ncte-india.org">www.ncte-india.org</a> within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
