WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, AVM Educational Society, Adarsha Bhavan, Musi Road, Road No.1, Nakrekal, Nalgonda District, Andhra Pradesh had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE on 30.01.2004 for grant of recognition for D.Ed course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students at AVM Institute of Elementary Teacher Education, Adarsha Nagar, Mossi Road, Post Office and Mandal, Nakrekal, Nalgonda District, Andhra Pradesh.

WHEREAS the file was under process and in the meanwhile, in view of the recommendations of the State Government of Andhra Pradesh vide letter dated 07.01.2009 not to further recognise/permit the institutions for conducting B.Ed, D.Ed, Physical Education, Language Pandit course(s).

WHEREAS the SRC in its 169th Meeting held on 12th - 13th January, 2009 having considered the letter dated 07.01.2009 of State Government of Andhra Pradesh and decided to give effect to the above decision of State Government of Andhra Pradesh as such, with immediate effect.

A letter dated 07.02.2009 forwarded by Principal Secretary of Education requesting not to accord further recognition/permission to the new colleges/private B.Ed, D.Ed, Physical Education, Language Pandit in the State of Andhra Pradesh as the above colleges are exceeding in numbers than required.

WHEREAS a letter dated 17.03.2009 has been received from NCTE, Hqrs informing that the "The recommendations of the Govt. of Andhra Pradesh not to grant recognition/permission in respect of other courses like B.Ed, D.Ed and Physical Education courses have further been decided that no further Recognition/ Permission to any institution in the State of Andhra Pradesh be considered by SRC for the academic session 2009-2010 for B.Ed, D.Ed, and Physical Education courses also".

WHEREAS the State Government vide its letter dated 20.03.2009 informed that it has been decided not to recommend the name of this institution. The letters dated 07.01.2009, 07.02.2009, 17.03.2009 and 20.03.2009 was considered by SRC in its 172nd Meeting held on 25-26 March, 2009 and SRC decided to accept the recommendation of the State Government of Andhra Pradesh, not to grant recognition to any of the Teacher Training Institutions in the State of Andhra Pradesh for the year 2009-2010 and decided to close the applications.

WHEREAS as per the decision of SRC the application was closed on 29.04.2009.

AND WHEREAS the Institute has approached to Hon'ble High Court in W.P.No.4387/2011.



WHEREAS, the Hon'ble High Court has passed an order on 28.02.2011 vide W.P.No.4387 of 2011 reads as hereunder:

"While following the judgment of this court in writ petition No.6712 of 2009 dated 16.12.2009, this writ petition is allowed and the order dated 29.04.2009 issued vide proceedings No.F.SRO/NCTE/2008-09/12127 is set aside with a direction to the respondents to reconsider the matter afresh by applying the policy, which was in force at the time when the petitioners have applied for grant of permission to run D.Ed course.

It is, however, made clear that if any deficiencies are pointed out by the respondents, the petitioners have to comply with the same as per the earlier policy of the Government and the existing regulations framed under the National Council for Teachers Education Act".

WHEREAS the Committee considered the matter and decided to process the application on submission of original application, and related supporting documents including Rs. 40000 towards inspection fee, within 60 days from the date of issue of letter.

WHEREAS as per direction of SRC, a letter issued to the applicant institution on 23/05/2011. The institution has submitted reply vide letter dated 27/05/2011.

WHEREAS the Committee in its 208th meeting held on 9-10th June 2011, considered the reply of the institution vide letter dt.03.06.2011 and all the relevant documentary evidences and it was decided to serve Show cause Notice under Section 17 of NCTE Act for the following:

- 1) The institution was not in possession of the land at the time of making of application. As per sale deed the land is registered on 11/05/2011, in favour of AVM institute of Elementary Teacher Education, which is against NCTE norms.
- 2) Fresh FDRs for Rs. 5 & 3 lakhs from a Nationalized Bank in joint account is to be submitted.
- 3) Affidavit on Rs.100/- stamp paper duly notarized in the prescribed format to be submitted.
- 4) In the building plan plot no. / Khasara no. is not mentioned.
- 5) Change of Land Use Certificate from competent Government authority is to be submitted.
- 6) The survey no. 10 & 14 was registered on 11.05.2011 after making of the application. BCC & CLU and building plan issued by competent authority for survey no. 10 & 14, whereas the land was on the lease basis at the time of the application.

WHEREAS as per the direction of SRC Show Cause Notice was issued to the applicant institution on 04.07.2011 in response to SRC letter dated 04.07.2011 the institution has submitted reply vide letter dated 11.07.2011.

WHEREAS the committee in its 211th Meeting of SRC held on 21st - 23rd September, 2011 considered the written reply and all other relevant documents and decided to cause inspection at the premises. The institution is directed to submit inspection fee of Rs. 40,000/-

WHEREAS in addition, the management be directed to exercise the option of either to be bound by old or current regulations considering their reply for the first point of the deficiency pointed above.

WHEREAS as per the direction of SRC inspection of the institution was carried on 06.11.2011.

WHEREAS, VT Report and other related documents have been received to SRC-NCTE on 08.11.2011.

WHEREAS the Committee in its 216th meeting held on 11th- 12th January 2012 considered the VT Report, VCD and all the relevant documentary evidences and it was decided to serve Final Show cause Notice under Section 14 of NCTE Act for the following:

- Address of the college in the application and address of the VT inspection are different.
- In the approved building plan submitted by the institution, the survey numbers with location is not mentioned.
- Total built up area in Building completion certificate shown as 25100 sq.ft. Whereas in VT report it is mentioned as 8386.60 sq.ft. both are not matching.
- Original Non-encumbrance certificate from competent Govt. authority is not submitted.
- Land usage Certificate from the concerned Government authorities (from revenue department) stating that the land is exclusively permitted / sanctioned for educational Purposes only is not submitted.
- As per the BCC & Affidavit the building is located in Sy.No. 10 & 14 and the land documents submitted for Sy.No. 10 & 14 are after the date of application.
- As per VT report, the size of the multipurpose hall is only 500 sq.ft only, which is grossly inadequate as per NCTE norms of 2000 sq.ft. required.
- No proof is submitted by the institution regarding the scale of pay offered to the staff is as per Central/State Govt/UGC guidelines.

WHEREAS in view of the above, the Committee in its 216th meeting held on 11th- 12th January 2012 decided to issue a Final Show cause Notice to the institution as to why the recognition be not refused and thereby providing an opportunity to the institution to make a written representation within 21 days from the date of issue of the Notice along with necessary certificates/documents in order to take a final decision in the matter; failing which action will be taken including the refusal, based on the records available, with no further notice.

WHEREAS, a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 01/03/2012. The institution has submitted its written representation on 19/03/2012.

WHEREAS the SRC in its 223rd meeting held on 29th -31st May 2012 considered the reply of the institution vide letter dt. 19.03.2012 and all the relevant documentary evidences and it was decided to serve another Final Show cause Notice under section 14 (1) of NCTE Act, for the following:

- The institution was not in possession of the land at the time of making of application. As per sale deed the land is registered on 11/05/2011, in favour of AVM institute of Elementary Teacher Education, which is against NCTE norms.



- Approved blue print of the building plan issued by competent civil authority with all details is not submitted.
- As per BCC submitted, total built up area is only 29100 sq.ft for both B.Ed and D.Ed course, which is less than the requirement of 32000 sq.ft as per NCTE norms.
- The inspection of the institution was carried out at House No. 8-22/2, Block No. 8 with Survey No. 10/14 with total area of 3025 sq.yds, which is less than the requirement as per NCTE norms. The said land was registered on 11-05-2011, which is after making of the application, which is not permissible as per NCTE norms and the application for D.Ed course was received on 30.01.2004.
- As per VT report, the size of the multipurpose hall is only 500 sq.ft only, which is grossly inadequate as per NCTE norms of 2000 sq.ft. required
- The required land area for both B.Ed and D.Ed is 3000 sq.mtrs.
- Notarized land usage certificate from the Revenue divisional office stating that the agriculture land converted to non-agriculture for the purpose of educational institution only is not submitted. Proceedings of Revenue Divisional Officer not submitted for conversion of land from agricultural to educational purposes.
- The institution is running B.Ed course in the same building and is not following NCTE norms as it is not paying its staff UGC/State Govt/Central Govt. pay scales through Bank Cheque.

WHEREAS, a Final Show cause notice was issued to the institution on 04.07.2012. The institution has submitted its written representation on 03/07/2012.

WHEREAS the SRC in its 228th meeting considered the reply of the institution vide letter dt. 03.07.2012 and all the relevant documentary evidences and it was decided to serve Show cause Notice under NCTE Act, for the following:

- The institution is having two separate building for B.Ed and proposed D.Ed courses, separate building completion certificate for both the buildings from competent Govt. Engineer is to be submitted.
- Approved blue print of the building plan separately from the competent civil authority for both the buildings is to be submitted.
- Fresh VCD covering full view of the building and instructional facilities in each class rooms to be submitted.
- Top floor of the one building is roofed with Asbestos sheets which is not permissible as per NCTE norms.



WHEREAS, by seeing the website the institution has submitted written representation on 09.08.2012.

WHEREAS, the SRC in its 231st meeting held on 22nd –23rd August 2012 decided to issue LOI to the institution. The LOI was issued to the institution on 27.08.2012.

WHEREAS, the institution has replied to the LOI on 31.08.2012.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to AVM Institute of Elementary Teacher Education, Adarsha Nagar, Mossi Road, Post Office and Mandal, Nakrekat, Nalgonda District, Andhra Pradesh for conducting D.Ed Course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students from the academic session 2012-2013 under clause 7(11) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009 subject, to fulfillment of the following conditions:

- I. The endowment fund of Rs.5 lakhs and reserve fund of Rs 3 lakhs kept in joint account with SRC, NCTE should be maintained always. Loan raising or mortgaging of FDRs shall not be done.
 - II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
 - III. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009.
 - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
2. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.
 3. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
 4. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-
 - a) Sanctioned programmes along with annual intake in the institution;
 - b) Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph;
 - c) Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last , quarter;
 - d) Names of students admitted during the current session along with qualification, percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
 - e) Fee charged from students;



- f) Available infrastructural facilities;
 g) Facilities added during the last quarter;
 h) Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
 i) The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires
 j) Any wrong or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
5. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
