**ORDER**

**WHEREAS**, Deccan Educational Society, Plot No. 7-76, Kotagiri, Nizamabad-503207, Andhra Pradesh had submitted an application for recognition to Abdul Kalam DED College Minority institution, Plot No. 429/9, NS Road, Lingapur Village, Kamareddy Taluka, Nizamabad Dist- 503 111, Andhra Pradesh for D.El.Ed course on online 01.10.2010.

**AND WHEREAS**, the application was scrutinized and deficiency letter was issued to the institution on 16.12.2010 the institution has submitted written representation to the deficiency letter on 24.01.2011.

**AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 202<sup>nd</sup> meeting held on 14<sup>th</sup>-15<sup>th</sup> March, 2011 considered the reply of deficiency letter dt.24.01.2011 for the deficiencies and decided to cause inspection under section 14 of the of NCTE Act. Accordingly inspection was carried out on 01.04.2011.

**AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 204<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 27<sup>th</sup>-28<sup>th</sup> April, 2011 considered the VT reports, VCD and all the relevant documentary evidences it was decided to issue Show Cause Notice. Accordingly Show Cause Notice was issued on 25.05.2011.

**AND WHEREAS**, as per direction of Southern Regional Committee in its meeting 206<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> July 2011 letter of intent prior to recognition was issued to applicant institution on 20.07.2011.

**AND WHEREAS**, in response to this office letter dated 20.07.2011 the institution has submitted reply vide letter dated 11.08.2011.

**AND WHEREAS**, the SRC considered the matter in its 210<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> August, 2011 decided to issue Notice under Section 17 of NCTE Act. Accordingly, Notice was issued to the institution on 01.11.2011. The institution has submitted written representation on 24.10.2011 and 4.11.2011.

**AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed before SRC in its 213<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> November, 2011 and the Committee decided to seek information from the institution about Principal's qualification not being complete and ask for more details especially regarding the 5 year teaching experience.

AND WHEREAS, the institution has submitted reply on 9.12.2011 based on the 213<sup>th</sup> meeting placed in the NCTE website, which was placed in 215<sup>th</sup> meeting of SRC held on 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> December, 2011 and the Committee considered the matter and it was decided to serve Notice Under Section 17 of NCTE Act for the following deficiencies:-

- Principal's experience is inadequate as per NCTE norms. Experience certificates submitted by the candidate cannot be ascertained, whether the institutions are recognized or not.

AND WHEREAS, the institution has submitted reply on 23.1.2012 based on the 215<sup>th</sup> meeting placed in the NCTE website

AND WHEREAS, on careful perusal of the original file of the institution and approved staff profiles from the affiliating university/ body, submitted by the institution in response to the letter of Intent, the SRC in its 217<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 08<sup>th</sup>-09<sup>th</sup> February, 2012 decided that **Formal Recognition** be granted to D.El.Ed (SRCAPP403) course of two year duration with an annual intake of 50 (fifty only) students for the session 2012-2013 with reference to the totality of information collected and based on collective application of mind, subject to the rectification of deficiencies in staff list, if any.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to Abdul Kalam DED College Minority institution, Plot No. 429/9, NS Road, Lingapur Village, Kamareddy Taluka, Nizamabad Dist- 503 111, Andhra Pradesh for conducting D.El.Ed Course of two years duration from the academic session 2012-2013 under clause 7(11) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) with intake of 50 Students Regulations, 2009 subject, to fulfillment of the following conditions:

- I. The endowment fund of Rs.5 lakhs and reserve fund of Rs.3 lakhs kept in joint account with SRC, NCTE should be maintained always. Loan raising or mortgaging of FDRs shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2007.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.

Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.

The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-

1. Copy of the Application Form
2. Land and Building Particulars
3. Staff Profile
4. Recognition letter
5. Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
