PREAMBLE :

- Read : 1. *Judgement dated.24th August 2001 of Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka*in W.A 2999-3068 & 3075-3135/1999 (EDN-REG) & W.P.23977,32472-32532&37034-035/2000 (EDN-REG/P)*
2. *Arbitration Award of Justice.K.Shivshankar Bhat Dated.08.04.2002.*

Whereas the dispute between the two factions of the management of Afza Education Society, Bangarpet was referred to the Arbitration by Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka to Justice.K.Shivshankar Bhat.

Whereas the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka in its judgement (Read 1), has stated that "the provisional recognition to be granted by Southern Regional Committee of NCTE to be in operation for the academic year 2001-2002 will enure to the benefit of the successful party before the Arbitrator and its right to claim recognition before NCTE".

Justice K.Shivshankar Bhat has passed the Arbitral Award on 08.04.2002 (Read 2). As per the Arbitration Award the claimants 2 to 8 and respondents 1 & 2 shall continue to be the members of the Society and constitute the Managing Committee of the Society called Afza Education Society in Bangarpet town.

As per the Arbitration Award, the claimant 2 i.e., Smt.Noora Afza Bano, President, Afza Education Society, Bangarpet approached SRC-NCTE with the Arbitration Award and management resolution and requested for renewal of recognition for Afza Teacher Training Institute, Bangarpet, Kolar District, Karnataka run by Afza Education Society, Bangarpet.

Based on the Arbitration Award and the representation made by Smt.Noora Afza Bano, an inspection team was deputed to the Afza Teacher Training Institute, Bangarpet, Kolar District, Karnataka on 23rd July 2002 run by Afza Education Society, Bangarpet under the presidentship of Smt.Noora Afza Bano.

The inspection team has submitted the report. The inspection report was placed before the Southern Regional Committee in its 51st meeting held on 28.08.2002. The Committee considered the report of the inspection team and other documents furnished by the institution and observed that the institution has not complied with NCTE norms and decided to issue notice to the institution pointing out the following deficiencies :

- Teachers including Principal is not qualified as per Para 5 NCTE norms.
- Teacher pupil ratio is not maintained as per Para 4(C) of NCTE norms.
- Books available in the library are less and do not cater for the strength of the institution.
- Reserve fund is not deposited as per Para 10(6) of NCTE norms.

Accordingly a notice was issued by this office on 20.09.2002.

Smt.Noor Afza Bano, President, Afza Education Society, Bangarpet submitted the written representation for the notice in her letter dated.8.10.2002.

The written representation was placed before the Southern Regional Committee in its 53rd meeting held on 28th November 2002. The Regional Committee considered the written representation submitted and observed that the institution has taken steps to remove the deficiencies pointed out in the notice and has decided to accord recognition from the academic session 2002-2003 to the Afza Teacher Training Institute, Bangarpet run by Smt.Noor Afza Bano, President, Afza Education Society, Bangarpet, Kolar District, Karnataka.

Hence the order.

ORDER

In exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the National Council For Teacher Education (NCTE) Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee grants recognition to **Afza Teacher Training Institute, Bangarpet-563114, Kolar District run by Smt.Noor Afza Bano, President, Afza Education Society, Bangarpet-563114, Kolar District, Karnataka for Elementary Course** of two years duration from the academic session **2002-2003** with an annual intake of **60** students, subject to fulfilling the following conditions:

1. The institution will ensure that a Principal and Seven faculty members are in position for an intake of 60 students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Committee immediately and in any case not later than one month from the date of commencement of the course.



2. The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
3. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfilment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like DSERT / State Government etc.,
4. The institution shall ensure library, laboratories and other instructional and infrastructure as per the NCTE norms.
5. The admission to the approved course shall be given only to those candidates who are eligible as per the regulations governing the course and in the manner laid down by the State Government.
6. Tuition fee and other fees will be charged from the students as per the norms of the State Government till such time NCTE regulations in respect of fee structure come into force.
7. Curriculum transaction, including practical work / activities, should be organised as per the norms and standards for the course and the requirements of the examining body.
8. Teaching days including practice teaching should not be less than the number fixed in the NCTE norms for the course.
9. The institution shall maintain reserve fund equivalent to three months salary of staff as per NCTE norms.
10. The institution shall continue to fulfil the norms laid down under the regulations of the NCTE and submit to the Regional Committee the Annual Report and the Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year. The performance appraisal report should inter alia give the extent of compliance of the conditions indicated above.

If Afza Teacher Training Institute, Bangarpet-563114, Kolar District run by Smt.Noor Afza Bano, President, Afza Education Society, Bangarpet-563114, Kolar District, Karnataka contravenes the provisions of the NCTE Act or the rules, regulations and orders made or issued thereunder or fails to fulfill the above conditions, the Regional Committee may withdraw this recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
