**ORDER**

**WHEREAS** in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Al-Ameen Educational Society, H.No. 50-349-L-21-A, Arora Nagar, B.Camp, Kurnool District – 518002, Andhra Pradesh** had submitted an application on **31.10.2008** for grant of recognition for **D.El.Ed** course of two year duration with an annual intake of 50 students at **Al- Madina Elementary Teacher Education, Plot No. 109/B3, 024 Near Zamia Masjid, Mungalapadu Village and Post, Kurnool District, Pin – 518 004, Andhra Pradesh.**


**AND WHEREAS**, the application has been scrutinized and deficiency letter dt. 05.11.2008 was issued to the Institution giving 90 days time to remove the deficiencies, and other letter dt. 05.11.08 along with the copy of the application was sent to the Secretary, School Education Department, Andhra Pradesh for recommendation.

**AND WHEREAS**, the Institution had submitted its reply vide letter dt.04.02.2009. The file was under process and in the meantime, in view of the recommendations of the State Government of Andhra Pradesh not to further recognize / permit the Institutions for conducting the B.Ed, D.Ed Physical Education, Language Pandit courses – a Public notice was issued on 02.10.2009 to this effect that the application for the above courses from the state of Andhra Pradesh will not be considered for the academic session 2009-10 and such application shall be returned along with the processing fees and documents.

**AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 169<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> January, 2009 considered the letter dt. 07.01.2009 of the State Government of Andhra Pradesh and decided to give effect. A letter dt. 20.03.2009 was forwarded by the Principal Secretary of Education not accord further recognition/ permission to new colleges/private B.Ed, D.Ed, Physical Education, Language Pandit in the State of Andhra Pradesh as the above colleges are exceeding in numbers than required. The same was considered by the SRC in its 172<sup>nd</sup> Meeting held on 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> March, 2009 and decided to accept recommendation of the State Government of Andhra Pradesh, not to grant recognition to any Teacher training Institutions in the State Andhra Pradesh for the year 2009 -2010 and decided to close applications. Accordingly the application was closed vide order 13.04.2009.

**AND WHEREAS**, Al-Ameen Educational Society, Andhra Pradesh filed a Court case vide Writ Petition No. 15656 of 2011 in the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature of Andhra Pradesh Versus NCTE-SRC and Government of Andhra Pradesh School Education department as 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent respectively against the closure order. Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh at Hyderabad had passed an order on 13.04.2011 in WP No. 15656 of 2011 as under

"In the light of orders passed by the court in the similar Writ Petitions, W.P. No. 6712 of 2009, WP No. 9360 of 2010 and WP no. 11078 of 2010, there shall be a direction to first respondent to consider the petitioner's application for starting D.Ed., course in accordance with law without reference to the State Government's Policy dated 07.01.2009".

**AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 208<sup>th</sup> Meeting of SRC held on 13<sup>th</sup>-14<sup>th</sup> July, 2011 considered the Hon'ble court orders and decided to process the application and the institution be directed to submit all the relevant original documents. 

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**AND WHEREAS**, as per decision of Regional Committee a letter was issued to resubmit the application on 30.08.2011. The institution has submitted its reply vide letter dt. nil on 19.09.2011. The reply of the documents submitted by the institution on 19.09.2011.

**AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 214<sup>th</sup> Meeting of SRC held on 28<sup>th</sup> November, 2011 considered the reply of the institution dt. 19.09.2011 and decided to cause inspection of the institution for D.Ed (APS09704) course to verify the infrastructural and instructional facilities provided, on payment of Rs. 40,000/- inspection fee.

**AND WHEREAS**, as per the direction of SRC inspection of the institution was carried on 28.12.2011. The VT Report and other related documents have been received to SRC-NCTE on 30.12.2011.

**AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 216<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> January 2012, considered the VT Report, VCD and all the relevant documentary evidences and it was decided to serve Show cause Notice under Section 14 of NCTE Act for the following:

**AND WHEREAS**, as per direction of committee, a Show Cause Notice issued on 22.02.2012. The institution has submitted reply vide letter dated 16.02.2012.

**AND WHEREAS**, the matter was again placed before SRC in 217<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 28<sup>th</sup> February, the Regional Committee considered the matter and decided to issue SCN to the applicant institution. The institution has submitted reply vide letter dated 22.03.2012,

**AND WHEREAS**, the matter is placed before SRC in its 221<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 19<sup>th</sup>-20<sup>th</sup> April 2012 and SRC decided to issue Letter of Intent before grant of unconditional recognition.

**AND WHEREAS**, accordingly, Letter of Intent was issued to the institution on 30.04.2012. The institution has submitted the written representation on 27.07.2012.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to **Al- Madina Elementary Teacher Education, Plot No. 109/B3, 024 Near Zamia Masjid, Mungalapadu Village and Post, Kurnool District, Pin – 518 004, Andhra Pradesh** for conducting D.El.Ed Course of two year duration with an annual intake of 50 students from the academic session 2012-2013 under clause 7(11) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009 subject, to fulfillment of the following conditions:

- I. The endowment fund of Rs.5 lakhs and reserve fund of Rs.3 lakhs kept in joint account with SRC, NCTE should be maintained always. Loan raising or mortgaging of FDRs shall not be done.
  - II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
  - III. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009.
  - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
2. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.

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3. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
4. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-
  - a) Sanctioned programmes along with annual intake in the institution;
  - b) Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph;
  - c) Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last , quarter;
  - d) Names of students admitted during the current session along with qualification, percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
  - e) Fee charged from students;
  - f) Available infrastructural facilities;
  - g) Facilities added during the last quarter;
  - h) Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
  - i) The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires
  - j) Any wrong or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition
5. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
