ORDER


WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Sappers Village Uplift Welfare Association, Kolar District, Karnataka has submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition to Amar Teacher Training Institute, Near Omkara Kshetra, Bangarpet Main Road, Hudukula Post, Bangarpet Taluk, Kolar District, Karnataka for Elementary(D.Ed) course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 (Fifty) Students.

2. AND WHEREAS on scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, the Committee is satisfied that the institution fulfills the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the said teacher education programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratories etc for running the programme and has appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.
3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Amar Teacher Training Institute, Near Omkara Kshetra, Bangarpet Main Road, Hudukula Post, Bangarpet Taluk, Kolar District, Karnataka for conducting Elementary(D.Ed) course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50(Fifty) students under clause 7(12) of Regulations dated.13.01.2006. This order of recognition shall be prospective and take effect from the date of issue of this order, subject to fulfillment of the following:
 - i) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Southern Regional Committee.
 - ii) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
 - iii) The institution shall shift to its own premises / building within three years from the date of recognition. (in case the course is started in rented premises)

- iv) The institution will ensure that Principal and Five faculty members duly approved by DSERT, Bangalore are in position for an intake of 50 students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately.
4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University / bodies, State Government etc, as applicable.
5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
6. The institution shall maintain & update the Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations.
7. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

PROCEEDINGS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF KARNATAKA


Subject: Issue of a No-Objection Certificate for establishment of a Teacher Training Institution.

Read: 1) Government Order No. ED 70 PTI 2003, dated 17-7-2003.
2) Government Order No. ED 136 PTI 2005, dated 16-07-2005.
3) Government Order No. ED 409 PTI 2005, dated 12-09-2005.

Preamble:

Orders were issued as contained in the Government Order dated 17-7-2003 read at (1) above, lifting the ban on issue of No Objection Certificates (NOCs) for establishment of TTIs offering Diploma in Education (D.Ed.) and C.P.Ed. courses subject to the conditions stipulated therein. [C.P.Ed. course is now called Diploma in Physical Education (D.P.Ed.) Course]. In accordance with the said Government Order dated 17-07-2003, the Director (R&T), Department of State Education Research and Training, Bangalore invited applications. The last date for receiving applications was 20-08-2003. After having received the applications the said Director submitted to Government a list of all the applicant-institutions along with the details relating to them. It contained the details of fresh applicant-institutions as also those of the applicant-institutions, which had applied in accordance with the earlier Government Order No. ED 110 PTI 2001, dated 27-07-2001 but had not been issued NOCs thereunder, as the Government Order dated 17-07-2003, read at (1) above, provided for considering the latter category of applications as new applications made thereunder. After having examined the said list, Government issued NOCs to the applicant-institutions. This process was completed.

2. Government has, now, issued orders as contained in the Government Order dated 16-07-2005, read at (2) above, prescribing detailed procedure relating to the issue of NOCs for starting teacher training institutions offering D.Ed., and D.P.Ed courses every year. The said procedure comprises various stages such as the initial stage of inviting applications after giving publicity, processing them at various stages (including inspection of the applicant-institutions) to the ultimate stage of issuing NOCs. In accordance with the said procedure, the various District Institutions of Education and Training in the State invited applications from private educational institutions seeking sanction of NOCs for establishing the teacher training institutions referred to above. The last date for receiving applications was 25-08-2005, which was extended to 20-09-2005. After the applications were received, the

applicant-institutions were inspected by the inspection teams constituted for the purpose. Thereafter, the Principals of the District Institutes of Education and Training forwarded their recommendations to the said Director. The latter examined the proposals received from the said Principals and submitted to Government a list of all the applicant-institutions along with the details relating to them.

3. After having considered the proposals received from the said Director, Government hereby orders as follows.



4. Government are pleased to hereby issue No-Objection Certificate to Sappers Village Uplift Welfare Association, Hudukulu, Bangarpet Kolar District for establishing a Teacher Training Institution offering D.Ed. course with Kannada as the medium of instruction, with an intake of 50 (fifty only) at Hudukula, Bangarpet, Kolar District subject to the following conditions:-

- (1) No grant-in-aid shall be sought from Government;
- (2) The institution shall provide adequate infrastructure, staff etc., as per the norms and standards prescribed by the National Council for Teacher Education;
- (3) The institution shall give an undertaking to the effect that it shall abide by the State Government's orders/rules relating to admission of students and recruitment of staff to the institution issued from time to time, failing which the NOC granted shall be withdrawn;
- (4) Statement of annual returns and list of members of the committee/Governing Council of the management as duly accepted/approved by the District Registrar shall be submitted every year to the Principal of the DIET concerned along with a list of the candidates admitted in the management quota for approval of the Principal of the DIET concerned;
- (5) Any change in the management shall be permissible with prior approval of Government before the commencement

- of each academic year, failing which the management shall attract penal action in accordance with law;
- (6) The institution shall collect 'Tuition fee' and 'Other fee' as regulated by the Government from time to time. The amount so levied or collected shall be exclusively utilised by the Institution in accordance with rules;
- (7) No shifting of the institution shall be allowed except with prior approval of Government;
- (8) Closure of the institution shall be permissible only after obtaining prior approval of the Government;
- (9) The management should start the institution only after obtaining recognition from the National Council for Teacher Education.


