Preamble :

The Bharatidasan University, Tiruchirapally, Tamilnadu has made an application to SRC-NCTE for establishment of B.Ed- Distance Education programme on 31.12.2004.

On verification of the file, the State Government of Tamilnadu vide its letter No.25275/2004-1 dated.24.12.2004 has issued NOC to the University for B.Ed-Distance Education programme. Further, the Distance Education Council (DEC), New Delhi vide its letter F.No.DEC/Recog/BDU/2006/3246 dated.15.02.2006 has issued no objection certificate for launching of B.Ed programme through distance mode by using IGNOU B.Ed course material.

In view of the above, a joint committee of NCTE-DEC visited the University for assessment of infrastructural and instructional facilities created for B.Ed – Distance Education programme on 29.07.2006.

The joint committee report was placed before SRC-NCTE in its 116th meeting held on 22-23 August, 2006. The committee considered the joint committee report and decided to accord recognition to the Bharatidasan University, Tiruchirapally, Tamilnadu for offering B.Ed through Distance Education mode with an intake of 500 students from the academic session 2006-07.

Hence the order.

ORDER

1. In exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **Centre for Distance Education, Bharatidasan University, Palkalaiperur, Tiruchirapalli-620024, Tamilnadu** for **B.Ed through Distance Education** course of **two years** duration from the academic session **2006-2007** with an annual intake of **500** students subject to fulfillment of the following.
 - a. The University shall ensure that the qualified minimum core faculty for the course comprising of one Professor, one Reader and four Lecturers duly approved by Registrar are in position for an intake of **500** students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately.

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
- b. Appointment of teachers shall be so distributed as to ensure the required nature and level of expertise for all teaching methodology courses and foundation courses
 - c. Administrative & other non-teaching staff essential for smooth running of the course shall be provided at the Headquarters.
 - d. Study centres shall be located only in teacher education institutions offering regular B.Ed. programme which have been recognized by the NCTE.
 - e. Maximum number of students enrolled through a study centre shall not exceed 100 in a batch.
 - f. The principal or a senior member of the institution shall be appointed as the Coordinator. One faculty member of the institution shall be appointed as the Assistant Co-ordinator. Supporting staff required for smooth running of the programme shall be provided in the Study Centre.
 - g. Self-learning print and non-print courseware designed and developed as per DEC norms will be made available to the students
 - h. Formative and summative evaluation shall be conducted in all curricular and co-curricular areas of the course. It shall be ensured that regular feedback based on evaluation of assignment, practicals, and other assessments is given to each student
 - i. In order to ensure smooth transaction of learning activities and proper functioning of Study Centres regular monitoring shall be conducted by the core faculty at the Headquarters.
4. The University shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.
 5. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like the UGC, DEC, State Government etc.
 6. The University shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the Registrar of the University to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

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7. If the University contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the Provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.
