Preamble :

Bharathiyar Teacher Training Institute, Attur – 636102, Salem District, Tamilnadu had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for D.T.Ed. Course.

Hon'ble High Court of Madras in W.P.23512 of 2005 has directed NCTE to cause inspection within a period of 3 months. Accordingly, an inspection was carried out on 05.08.2005. The inspection report was placed before 98th SRC meeting held during 10th August 2005.

After considering the application and other relevant materials furnished by the applicant institution, had noted that the applicant institution does not fulfill the requirements and issued a letter on 14.10.2005 to the applicant institution thereby giving an opportunity to the said applicant institution to make a written representation in this behalf.

The written representation submitted by the said institution dated 18.11.2005 was considered by the Regional Committee in its 106th meeting held on 15-16 December 2005 and decided to accord recognition.

Some of the institutions who have been granted recognition for the subsequent year have preferred appeal before NCTE, New Delhi to reconsider their cases of grant of recognition for the session 2005-06 itself instead of 2006-06. The NCTE, New Delhi vide order No.F.No.89-156/2005 Appeal dated.28.9.2005 has remanded back the case to SRC with a direction to reconsider these cases immediately for grant of recognition for the session 2005-06.

SRC in its 104th meeting held on 9-10 November, 2005 has considered the legal opinion obtained in this regard and has taken decision to grant recognition to the session 2005-06 to those institutions who have submitted belated NOCs/Endorsements and also the essential documents mentioned in Appendix-1B of NCTE Regulations as one time exception.

Hence the order.

ORDER

In terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Bharathiyar Teacher Training Institute, Attur – 636102, Salem District, Tamilnadu had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for D.T.Ed. Course of two year duration from the academic session 2005-06 with an annual intake of 50

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2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:
 - a. The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
 - b. The institution has made arrangements for conducting the course in the rented premises.
 - c. The institution has created an Endowment Fund of Rs.5 lakhs and a Reserve Fund of Rs. 3 lakhs.
 - d. The institution has selected the Principal and five lecturers for the said course.
3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **Bharathiyar Teacher Training Institute, Attur – 636102, Salem District, Tamilnadu** for D.T.Ed. course of **two year duration** from the academic session 2005-2006 with an annual intake of **50** students subject to fulfillment of the following.
 - a. The institution will ensure that Principal and five faculty members duly approved by affiliating University are in position for an intake of **50** students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately.
 - b. The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the Endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Southern Regional Committee.
 - c. The institution shall shift to its own premises / building within three years from the date of recognition. (in case the course is started in rented premises)
 - d. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.
4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like the affiliating University, UGC, State Government etc.
5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating University to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

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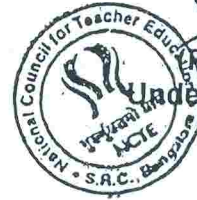

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the Provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.
