**ORDER**

In terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **C. B. R. TELUGU PANDIT TRAINING COLLEGE, C/o. C.B.R. MODEL SCHOOL, SHANTINAGAR, ADILABAD – 504 001, ANDHRA PRADESH** had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for accord of recognition for the **TELUGU PANDIT TRAINING** course with an intake of **50 students** of **One year** duration from the academic session **2003-04**.

1. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:

- i) The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- ii) The institution has constructed the building for conducting the course on the above-mentioned land.
- iii) The institution has selected the Principal / Head and 6 teachers for the said course.

2. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants permission to **C. B. R. TELUGU PANDIT TRAINING COLLEGE, C/o. C.B.R. MODEL SCHOOL, SHANTINAGAR, ADILABAD – 504 001, ANDHRA PRADESH** for **TPT Course of One year** from the academic session **2003-2004** with an intake of **50 students** subject to fulfillment of the following :

- a) The institution will ensure that **1+3** faculty members duly approved by the Director, SCERT are in position for an intake of **50** students i.e. before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Committee immediately.
- b) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of order, convert the endowment fund into a joint account for Rs. One lakh & Reserve fund for Rs. 50,000/- to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
- c) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations and the institution shall be visited on any day after three months from the date of issue of recognition order for ensuring its satisfactory performance.

The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the Director, SCERT to the appointment of faculty members, if there is any change in the previous staff list and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

3. If the institution contravenes any of the above condition or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the Provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
