**ORDER**

WHEREAS, C.K.S. Educational Trust, Vellore, Tamilnadu submitted an application for seeking grant of recognition to C.K.S. Teacher Training Institute, No.75, Railway Station Road, Gudiyattam, Vellore District-632602, Tamilnadu for D.T.Ed course on 02.01.2006.

And whereas, the application was processed and as per the provisions contained in Rules and Regulation, Norms and Standards prevalent at that point of time and the recognition was granted to the institution vide its order dated 23.10.2006 with certain stipulated conditions.

And whereas, the State Government of Tamilnadu vide its letter No.6987/U1-80-1 dated 20.03.2008 has informed certain irregularities by self-financing Teacher Training Institutions and recommended withdrawal of recognition for such institutions. The SRC considered the letter in its 157<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 23-24<sup>th</sup> April 2008 and decided to issue notice under section of NCTE Act. Accordingly notice under section 17 was issued to the institution on 17.06.2008. The institution submitted its reply on 16.07.2008.

And whereas, SRC considered the reply in its 165<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 18<sup>th</sup>-19<sup>th</sup> October 2008 and decided to cause inspection of the institution under section 17 of NCTE Act, to verify the veracity of the compliance as claimed by the institution and also the structural modifications/improvement/shifting to new building as claimed, on payment of re-inspection fee of Rs.40000/- by the institution. Accordingly a letter was issued to the institution to submit Rs.40000/- on 27.10.2008. The institution submitted its reply on 11.11.2008 along with Rs.40000/-

And whereas, as per decision of SRC in its 175<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 13<sup>th</sup>-14<sup>th</sup> May 2009, the office of SRC has reviewed the files of the institution who have been granted recognition either in a rented premises pending construction of own building or in lease premises. A list of such institutions has been prepared and placed before SRC in its 181<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup>-21<sup>st</sup> August 2009 wherein, it was decided that the institution which have not shifted to the permanent premises even after the expiry of three years time limit be issued notice under Section 17 of NCTE Act for further action.

And whereas, a notice was issued to the institution on 23.07.2010 to submit the enclosed documents. The institution submitted its reply on 23.08.2010 along with photocopies of certain documents. The committee considered the matter in its 196<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 15<sup>th</sup>-16<sup>th</sup> September 2010 and decided to cause inspection for shifting of premises.

And whereas, inspection of the institution for shifting of premises was conducted on 16.11.2010. The Committee in its 199<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 22<sup>nd</sup>-23<sup>rd</sup> December 2010 considered the VT Report, VCD and all the relevant documentary evidences and it was decided to serve Show cause Notice Under Section 17 of NCTE Act. Accordingly, show cause notice was issued to the institution on 04.02.2011. The institution submitted its reply on 24.02.2011.


And whereas, the committee in its 202<sup>nd</sup> meeting held on 14<sup>th</sup>-15<sup>th</sup> March 2011 considered the reply and has decided to issue Final Show Cause notice to the institution under section 17 of the NCTE Act, after careful consideration of the reply of the institution dt. 24.02.2011 for the show cause notice issued to the institution on 04.02.2011. Accordingly final show cause notice was issued to the institution on 18.04.2011. The institution submitted its reply on 23.05.2011.

And whereas, the Committee in its 206<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 09<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> June, 2011 considered the VT report of the institution, reply of the institution to the show cause notice and other related documents along with the original file of the institution, for shifting to new /permanent premises and **decided to permit shifting to new premises.**

NOW, THEREFORE, the institution is permitted to shift to **New permanent premises at Kakathoppu Village, Chettikuppam Post, Via Melalathur, Gudiyattam, Vellore, Tamilnadu** for conducting D.T.Ed course.

Also order that a copy of this order be published in the Official Gazette.
