ORDER

Whereas, Christ D.Ed. Institute, No.68, Jyothi Nagar, Kaggalipura, Bangalore, Karnataka had submitted application for D.Ed course on 26.12.2003. The institution was granted recognition for D.Ed course with an intake of 50 students on 02.12.2004.

And whereas, a letter No.ED 122 PTI 2008 (B) dated 18.06.2009 was received from the Principal Secretary, Primary and Higher Education, Education Department, Government of Karnataka and has recommended SRC to withdraw the recognition granted to D.Ed college, as the institution is not maintaining Norms and Standards as prescribed by NCTE.

And whereas, the matter was placed before SRC in its 178th meeting of SRC held on 13-14 July 2009. The SRC considered the recommendation of the State Government of Karnataka regarding withdrawal of recognition to D.Ed. College and decided to issue Show Cause Notice under Section 17 of the NCTE Act.

And whereas, accordingly, a notice was issued to the institution on 12.08.2009. The institution submitted its reply on 28.08.2009. The written representation was placed before SRC in its 183rd meeting held on 22.09.2009 and decided to issue notice under section 17 of NCTE Act which was issued to the institution on 04.11.2009. The institution submitted its written representation on 27.11.2009 and on 11.12.2009. SRC in its 188th meeting held on 28-29 January 2010 considered the written representation and decided to seek clarification. Accordingly, a clarification letter was issued to the institution on 04.03.2010. The institution submitted its clarification on 24.03.2010 and SRC in its 190th meeting held on 29-30 March 2010 decided to call clarification for the discrepancy which affects the credibility of the statements. Accordingly, another clarification letter was issued to the institution on 07.05.2010. The institution submitted its clarification on 02.06.2010.

And whereas, the SRC in its 193rd meeting held on 30-22 June 2010 considered the clarification letter and decided to cause inspection of the institution for D.Ed Course to verify the facts. Accordingly, the inspection of the institution was carried on 02.08.2010.

And whereas, the SRC in its 196th meeting held on 15-16 September 2010 considered the matter and decided to issue Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, Notice was issued to the institution on 26.10.2010. The institution submitted written representation on 25.11.2010.

And whereas, based on the reports submitted by the institution to the Show Cause Notice and the VT reports and other related documents, it was concluded that the management is not maintaining norms and standards prescribed for D.Ed course by NCTE. The institution was running other programmes like LKG, High School and PUC in the same campus, with no exclusive earmarking of land and building for D.Ed as per NCTE norms. The photographs submitted clearly indicate that the construction is in progress and incomplete.

And whereas, under the above grounds, the Committee decides to withdraw the recognition for D.Ed. course with effect from 2012-13 to enable the present batch of student to complete the course. But, it is made clear that the institution is debarred from making any further admission subsequent to the date of issue of this order.

And whereas, accordingly, withdrawal order was served to the institution on 4.2.2011.

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And whereas, aggrieved by the withdrawal order, the institution preferred an appeal the appellate authority on 10.05.2011, which was heard on 8-10-2011.


And whereas, the council noted that the appellant has proved adequate built-up area for running Christ D.Ed institution and VT also recorded that the institution was having 15819.95 sq.ft of built-up area for the course. The Council, therefore, came to the conclusion that there was adequate justification in accepting the appeal with a direction to SRC for restoration of the recognition of the institution.

And whereas, after perusal of documents, memorandum of appeal, affidavit, VT report and after considering oral arguments advanced during the hearing, the Council reached the conclusion that there was adequate ground to accept the appeal and reverse the SRC's order dt. 4.2.2011 vide order No. F.No.89-245/2011 Appeal/6th meeting-2011 dt. 4.11.2011 with direction to SRC for restoration of the recognition of the institution.

And whereas, the Committee in its 214th meeting held on 28th November, 2011 considered the Appellate authority order Dt. 04.11.2011 and **decided to restore recognition of the institution.**

Now Therefore, the recognition is hereby restored to **Christ D.Ed Institute, No.68, Jyothi Nagar, Kaggalipura, Bangalore, Karnataka** for conducting **D. Ed.** course.

Also order that a copy of this order be published in the Official Gazette.
