**ORDER**

**WHEREAS** in terms of Section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, **Gowthama Buddha Educational Society, Plot no. 4-19-19A, Pattabhipuram Post, 3<sup>rd</sup> Line, Vijayapuri Colony, JKC College Road, Guntur-522006, Andhra Pradesh** had submitted application on **25.05.2007** for grant of recognition for D.El.Ed course of two year duration with an annual intake of 50 students at **Dr. D.S.Kothari College of Education, Chillakallu-521178, Jaggayyapet Mandal, Krishna District, Andhra Pradesh**

**AND WHEREAS**, the institution was issued a deficiency letter dated 06.06.2007 giving a time of 90 days for submitting the compliance to the effect that all the deficiency communicated have been removed. The period of 90 days expired but the applicant institute did not submit any reply. The SRC considered in its 135<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> June 2007 considered the matter and decided to closed the file and inform the institute about the decision. As per the decision of SRC a letter was issued to the institution on 06.11.2007.

**AND WHEREAS**, the institute has approached to Hon'ble High Court in W.P.No.19647 of 2010. The Hon'ble High Court has passed an order on 11.08.2010 vide W.P.No. 19647 of 2010 as under:

*"The matter is squarely covered by the judgment, dated 16.12.2009 in W.P.No.6712 of 2009. Thereby, a learned Judge of this Court held that the power of the State Government to review the policy as to the necessity or otherwise of according permission to establish new colleges could not be extended to existing institutions. The learned Judge observed that the right that accrued to such colleges could not be taken away on account of subsequent change of policy.*

*In terms of the afore-stated decision, the writ petition is disposed of directing the National Council for Teacher Education to consider the petitioner college's case for granting permission for commencing D.Ed.,course independently and pass appropriate orders as expeditiously as possible. No order as to the costs".*

**AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 198<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 24<sup>th</sup>-26<sup>th</sup> November 2010 considered the Hon'ble High Court order and decided to process the application on submission of original application and related supporting documents. As per decision of SRC a letter was issued to the institution on 12.07.2011 with request to submit original documents. Now, the institution has submitted its reply dated 08.07.2011.

**AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 203<sup>rd</sup> meeting held on 31<sup>st</sup> March & 1<sup>st</sup> April 2011 considered the matter and decided to cause inspection of the institution for D.Ed. Course, to ascertain infrastructural and instructional facilities

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AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 205<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 18<sup>th</sup> – 19<sup>th</sup> May 2011 considered the VT Report, VCD and all the relevant documentary evidences and it was decided to serve Show cause Notice for the following:

- Non-Encumbrance certificate from the competent authority is to be submitted.
- In the affidavit submitted, built up area is shown as 1100 sq.mts, where as in VT report it shown as 16255 sq.ft. This discrepancy may be explained.

AND WHEREAS, as per direction of SRC SCN was issued on 12.07.2011. In response to this office letter dated 12.07.2011 the institution has submitted reply vide letter dated 08.07.2011

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 209<sup>th</sup> meeting hold on 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2011 considered the reply of the institution dated 08.07.2011, explaining/clarifying the points, raised in the show cause notice and decided to issue letter of intent prior to grant of recognition under clause 7(9) of the NCTE regulation, for grant of recognition to D.El.Ed course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50(Fifty only)(one unit) for the academic year 2011-12 subject to the appointment of qualified staff through duly constituted selection committee (within 10 days) as per the Norms of NCTE/State Government/Affiliating University and be given effect before the commencement of the academic session.

AND WHEREAS, however, since during the period of minutes of the SRC were called for by NCTE Hqrs, the file was sent and NCTE Hqrs observed that:

1. The appeal matter related to B.Ed course of your college was heard in compliance of the court direction and the decision is not yet conveyed. It is not clear from the VT reports whether the college is running B.Ed course or not under court directions. Hence the total facts of the college may be submitted to SRC at the earliest so that the same could be placed before the Regional Committee for appropriate decision.
2. The institution may also inform whether the building and other facilities for the B.Ed course is distinct and different from that for D.Ed course.

AND WHEREAS, accordingly, a letter was issued to the institution on 09/11/2011. The institution has submitted written representation on 02.01.2012.

AND WHEREAS, on careful perusal of the original file of the institution, reply of the institution dt. 02.01.2012 and other related documents, Act of NCTE, 1993, Regulations and guidelines of NCTE published from time to time laid on the table, the Regional Committee decided to issue Letter of Intent for grant of recognition to D.El.Ed course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50(Fifty only)(one unit) for the academic year 2012-2013 subject to the appointment of qualified staff through duly constituted selection committee as per the Norms of NCTE/State Government/Affiliating University and be given effect before the commencement of the academic session. Accordingly, a letter of intent was issued to the institution on 01/02/2012. The institution has submitted the written representation on 11.06.2012.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 226<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 09<sup>th</sup> –10<sup>th</sup> July 2012 considered the reply of the institution and all the relevant documentary evidences and it was decided to serve Notice Under NCTE Act. Accordingly, by seeing the website the institution has submitted written representation on 26.07.2012.

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
NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to Dr. D.S.Kothari College of Education, Chillakallu-521178, Jaggayyapet Mandal, Krishna District, Andhra Pradesh for conducting D.El.Ed Course of two year duration with an annual intake of 50 students, from the academic session 2012-2013 under clause 7(11) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009 subject, to fulfillment of the following conditions:

- I. The endowment fund of Rs.5 lakhs and reserve fund of Rs.3 lakhs kept in joint account with SRC, NCTE should be maintained always. Loan raising or mortgaging of FDRs shall not be done.
  - II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
  - III. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009.
  - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
2. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.
  3. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
  4. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-
    - a) Sanctioned programmes along with annual intake in the institution;
    - b) Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph;
    - c) Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last , quarter;
    - d) Names of students admitted during the current session along with qualification, percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission,etc.;
    - e) Fee charged from students;
    - f) Available infrastructural facilities;
    - g) Facilities added during the last quarter;
    - h) Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
    - i) The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires
    - j) Any wrong or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition

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5. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
