ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 J.K. Teacher Training Institute & J.K. College of Education, 4/360, J.K. Nagar, Dindigul-624001, Tamilnadu had submitted the applications to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for B.Ed, M.Ed, D.T.Ed & D.T.Ed-AI Course on 21.12.2005, 03.03.2008, 26.12.2002 and 28.12.2005 respectively.

AND WHEREAS, the Southern Regional Committee, after considering the report of the visiting team as well as other relevant materials granted recognition to the institution for B.Ed course on 27.07.2007 with an annual intake of 100 students, M.Ed course on 29.05.2009 with an annual intake of 35 students, D.T.Ed course on 24.10.2006 with an annual intake of 50 students and D.T.Ed-AI course on 22.06.2007 thus making an annual intake of 100 students, which includes the existing intake of 50 and additional intake of 50 students. with stipulation that the institution shall shift to its own premises/building within three years from the date of recognition.

AND WHEREAS, the institution vide letter dated 20.10.2008 submitted Rs. 40,000/- towards shifting fee for D.T.Ed course.

AND WHEREAS, as per decision of SRC in its 175th meeting held on 13-14 May 2009, the office of SRC had reviewed the files of the institution who were granted recognition either in a rented premises pending construction of own building or in lease premises. A list of such institutions was prepared and placed before SRC in its 181st meeting held on 20-21 August 2009 wherein, it was decided that the institution which had shifted to the permanent premises even after the expiry of three years time limit be issued notice under Section 17 of NCTE Act for further action. A notice was issued to this institution on 23.07.2010. The institution submitted its reply on 31.08.2010.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 196th meeting held on 15-16 September 2010 considered the written representation and decided to cause inspection for shifting. The SRC also considered the reply dated 01.09.2010 to notice for B.Ed course of the institution and decided to cause inspection of the institution for shifting.

AND WHEREAS, the inspection of the institution for shifting of premises was conducted on 20.10.2010. The SRC in its 198th meeting held on 24-26 November 2010 considered the VT Report, VCD and all the relevant documentary evidences and decided to serve Show cause Notice under Section 17 of NCTE Act. Accordingly, show cause notice was issued to the institution on 06.01.2011 and the reply was not received for the same.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 204th meeting held on 27-28 April 2011 considered the VT Report, VCD and all the relevant documentary evidences and decided to serve Final Show Cause Notice under Section 17 of NCTE Act. Accordingly, a final show cause notice was issued to the institution on 27.05.2011(D.T.Ed) and 01.06.2011(B.Ed). The institution had submitted, its reply on 04.07.2011 for both the courses.

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AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 211th meeting held on 21-23 September, 2011 considered the reply of the institution dt. 04.07.2011, VT Report, VCD and all the relevant documentary evidences and decided to serve Final Show Cause Notice under Section 17 of NCTE Act. Accordingly, a Final Show cause notice was issued to the institution on 09.11.2011. The institution has submitted its reply on 18.11.2011 for B.Ed, M.Ed, D.T.Ed & D.T.Ed-AI courses.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 215th meeting held on 12-13 December, 2011 considered the reply of the institution dt. 18.11.2011 and all other relevant documents evidences and decided to permit for shifting to new premises on payment of Rs. 40,000/- and the Original Affidavit. Accordingly, a letter was issued to the institution on 15.02.2012.


WHEREAS, the institution vide its letter dtd. 10.02.2012 and 29.02.2012 along with DD bearing no. 515725 dtd. 01.02.2012 of Rs. 40,000/- for shifting fee and Notarised original affidavit at Patta No. 67 and sy no. 3/1A, 3/3, 6/3A, 6/5A1, 7/3A, 7/1, A. Vellodu Village, Dindigul Taluk and District, Tamilnadu with total land area of 7.02 acres and total built up area of 28335.82 sq.mts.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 220th meeting held on 30-31 March, 2012 considered the reply of the institution vide letter dt. 10.02.2012 and 29.02.2012 and other related documents along with the original file of the institution for shifting to new/permanent premises and decided to permit shifting to new premises is permitted.

NOW THEREFORE, permission is hereby accorded by SRC to **J.K. Teacher Training Institute & J.K. College of Education, 4/360, J.K. Nagar, Dindigul-624001, Tamilnadu** to shift its premises to the new location / building at **J.K. Teacher Training Institute & J.K. College of Education, NH-7, Madurai Road, Begampur Post, Dindigul-02, Tamilnadu** for all courses.

If the institution contravenes any of the conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
