PREAMBLE :

The K.R. Teacher Training Institute for Women, N.H.-7, K.R. Nagar, Vedasandur-624710, Dindigul District, Tamilnadu had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for Elementary Course on 30.12.2002.

In obedience to the court directions, inspection was carried out on 19.06.2004. After considering the report the visiting team as well as other relevant materials furnished by the applicant institution, had noted that the applicant institution does not fulfill the requirements and issued a notice on 9.9.2004 to the applicant institution under proviso to Section 14(3)(b) of the NCTE, 1993, thereby giving an opportunity to the said applicant institution to make a written representation in this behalf.

Further, applicant institution had submitted the written representation on 27.09.2004. The said representation was considered by the Regional Committee on 11th October, 2004 and the Committee decided to refuse recognition.

Accordingly, order of refusal was issued vide letter No.F.TN/N-782/ELE/SRO/NCTE/2004-05/8197 dated 29.10.2004.

The applicant institution preferred appeal under Section 18 of NCTE Act, before NCTE, New Delhi. The Appellate Authority considering the appeal passed an order vide F.No.89-12/2005-Appeal dated 29.4.2005 reversing the decision of SRC.

The order of Appellate Authority was placed before SRC in its meeting held during 26-27th May, 2005. The Committee decided to issue recognition order to the appellant institution from the session 2005-06.

ORDER

In terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **K.R. Teacher Training Institute for Women, N.H.-7, K.R. Nagar, Vedasandur-624710, Dindigul District, Tamilnadu** had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for **Elementary** course of **two year** duration from the academic session **2005-06** with an annual intake of **50** students.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:
 - a. The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
 - b. The institution will ensure that the permanent building is constructed within a period of 3 years on the acquired land.
 - c. The institution has created an Endowment fund of Rs. 5.00 lakhs and a Reserve fund of Rs. 3.00 lakhs.
 - d. The institution has selected the **Principal** and **five** teachers for the said course and the list of faculty members is not approved by the DTERT, Chennai.


3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14 of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **K.R. Teacher Training Institute for Women, N.H.-7, K.R. Nagar, Vedasandur-624710, Dindigul District, Tamilnadu** for **Elementary course of two years duration** from the academic session **2005-2006** with an annual intake of **50** students subject to fulfillment of the following.
 - a. The institution will ensure that **Six** exclusive faculty members (Principal and five teachers) duly approved by the DTERT are in position for an intake of **50** students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Committee immediately. The faculty list is to be approved by the Director, DTERT, Chennai.
 - b. The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
 - c. The institution shall shift to its own premises within three years from the date of recognition (in case the course is started in temporary premises).
 - d. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.

4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC / University / State Government etc..



5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating body for the appointment of faculty members and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
7. The following certificates have to be submitted before commencement of the course.
 - a. Stability certificate issued by the Competent Authority.
 - b. Sanitation certificate issued by the Health Officer.
