ORDER

In terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Kastoorba Gandhi Memorial Pre-primary Teacher Training Institute, Thevally, Kollam - 691009, Kerala** had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for starting **Pre-primary course of one year duration** from the academic session **2002-2003** with an annual intake of **30** students.

On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:


- The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- The institution has made arrangements for conducting the course in temporary premises.
- The institution has created an Endowment Fund of Rs.5,000/- and a Reserve Fund of Rs.23,355/- as per State Government norms.
- The institution has selected the Principal and **four** teachers for the said course and the staff list is approved by SCERT, Kerala.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **Kastoorba Gandhi Memorial Pre-primary Teacher Training Institute, Thevally, Kollam - 691009, Kerala** for **Pre-primary course of one year duration** from the academic session **2002-2003** with an annual intake of **30** subject to fulfillment of the following.

- The institution will ensure that **five** faculty members are in position for an intake of **30** students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Committee immediately and in any case not later than one month from the date of commencement of the course.
- The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
- The institution shall shift to its own premises within three years from the date of recognition (in case the course is started in temporary premises).
- The infrastructure and instructional facilities are made adequate to conduct various activities as suggested in the norms.

- e) Books and journals be added to the library to fulfil NCTE norms.
 - f) Endowment and Reserve Fund shall be deposited as per NCTE norms.
 - g) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.
4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfilment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like State Government etc..
 5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating body for the appointment of faculty members and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
 6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
