ORDER

In exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the National Council For Teacher Education (NCTE) Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee grants recognition to **Kothamasu Chandrakala & B. Venkateshwarlu Hindi Pandit Training College, Nelapadu, Tenali P.O. – 522 201, Guntur Dt., Andhra Pradesh** to **Hindi Pandit course** of one year duration from the academic session **2002-2003** with an annual intake of **60**, subject to fulfilling the following conditions:-

1. The institution shall function with **five** teaching staff possessing the academic qualifications as laid down in the State Government norms, in the salary structure prescribed by the Central/State Government as the case may be.
2. The institution shall ensure library, laboratories and other instructional infrastructure as per the State Government norms.
3. The admission to the approved course shall be given only to those candidates who are eligible as per the regulations governing the course and in the manner laid down by the State Government.
4. Tuition fee and other fees will be charged from the students as per the norms of the State Government as the case may be till such time NCTE regulations in respect of fee structure come into force.
5. Curriculum transaction, including practical work / activities, should be organised as per the norms and standards for the course and the requirements of the examining body as the case may be.
6. Teaching days including practice teaching should not be less than the number fixed in the State Government norms for the course.
7. The institution, if unaided, shall maintain endowment and reserve fund as per State Government norms.


8. The institution shall continue to fulfil the norms laid down under the regulations of the State Government and submit to the Regional Committee the Annual Report and the Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year. The performance appraisal report should inter alia give the extent of compliance of the conditions indicated above.

The recognition now accorded is subject to review after the NCTE formulates and prescribes its own norms applicable to the Language Teacher Training Course.

This order of recognition is subject to the outcome of SLP filed in the Hon'ble Supreme Court against order of the Hon'ble Division Bench in W.A.No. 626/2000 of the High Court of Andhra Pradesh.

If **Kothamasu Chandrakala & B. Venkateshwarlu Hindi Pandit Training College, Nelapadu, Tenali P.O. - 522 201, Guntur Dt., Andhra Pradesh** contravenes the provisions of the NCTE Act or the rules, regulations and orders made or issued thereunder or fails to fulfill the above conditions, the Regional Committee may withdraw this recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
