ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, Mahaboob Khan Ghori Educational & Rural Development Society, Plot No.25-25-58/C, 1st Street, Cumbum Village & Post, Cumbum Taluk, Prakasam District – 523333, Andhra Pradesh had applied for grant of recognition to Mahammad Ghori D.Ed College, Plot/Khasara No.615, 1st Street, Kandulapuram Village & Post, Cumbum Taluk, Prakasam District – 523333, Andhra Pradesh for D.El.Ed course online on 28.06.2015 for two year duration under section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 and hardcopy was received by Southern Regional Committee of NCTE on 06.07.2015.

AND WHEREAS, on scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit submitted and the report received from VT and videography, and the certificates received from the university, the Committee in its 322nd meeting held on 20th & 21st October, 2015 is satisfied that the applicant fulfils the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the said teacher education programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, financial resources, etc., for running the programme.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE hereby grants recognition to Mahammad Ghori D.Ed College, Plot/Khasara No.615, 1st Street, Kandulapuram Village & Post, Cumbum Taluk, Prakasam District – 523333, Andhra Pradesh for conducting D.El.Ed programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (2 units) from the academic sessions 2017-2018 under Clause 7(16) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014 subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs.5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs.7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Loan raising against or mortgaging of FDRs shall not be done.
 - II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, as amended from time to time.
 - III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
 - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
2. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University / Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.
 3. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self- Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
 4. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter -alia , the details of the institution, its location, name of the programme applied for with intake; availability of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities or amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their proposed teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely:-

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- a. Sanctioned programmes along with annual intake in the institution;
 - b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
 - c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter;
 - d. Names of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
 - e. Fee charged from students;
 - f. Available infrastructural facilities;
 - g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
 - h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
 - i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
 - j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
 - k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
5. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
 6. The institution shall make available list of students admitted on its official website.
 7. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE website within one month from the date of this order.
 8. The institution shall follow uniform Accounting System as brought out by ICAI and accepted by MHRD.

If the institution Contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the regional committee under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

Also order that a copy of this order be published in the official Gazette.


