PREAMBLE:

Nachiyammal College of Physical Education, V.R. Nagar Village, Laxmi Puram P.O., Kovilpatti Taluk, Tuticorin District, Tamilnadu had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for C.P.Ed course from the session 2005-06 on 31.12.2002.

In obedience to the directions passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Madras in W.P. No. 22973 of 2003 SRC-NCTE caused inspection of the institution on 23.11.2005. The inspection report was placed before SRC in its 105th meeting held during 2-3rd December, 2005.

After considering the visiting team report and other relevant materials furnished by the applicant institution, SRC pointed out certain deficiencies and decided to issue notice to the institution under section 14(3)(b) of NCTE Act 1993, thereby giving an opportunity to the said applicant institution to make a written representation in this behalf. Accordingly a notice was issued on 14.12.2005.

The written representation submitted by the said institution on 21.12.2005 was considered by the Regional Committee in its 107th meeting held on 27th December, 2005 and SRC decided to seek clarification for land and also to produce original land documents for verification. Accordingly a letter was issued to the institution on 31.1.2006. The written representation submitted by the institution on 7.2.2006 regarding land documents was placed before SRC in its 110th meeting held on 24th February, 2006 and SRC decided to reject the proposal of the institution. Accordingly a rejection order was issued on 25.4.2006.

Aggrieved by the rejection order passed by SRC-NCTE the institution preferred an appeal dated 3.5.2006 to NCTE-Hqrs., New Delhi. Appellate Authority, New Delhi vide their order No. F.No. 89-85/2006-Appeal dated 19.7.2006 has reversed the order appealed against.

Hence the order.

Order

In terms of section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Nachiyammal College of Physical Education, V.R. Nagar Village, Laxmi Puram P.O., Kovilpatti Taluk, Tuticorin District, Tamilnadu** had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for C.P.Ed course of two years duration from the academic session 2005-06.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:

- a. The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- b. The institution has constructed the building for conducting the course on the above mentioned land.

OR

The institution has made arrangements for conducting the course in the rented premises.

- c. The institution has created an Endowment Fund of Rs.5 lakhs and a Reserve Fund of Rs.3.00 lakhs.
- d. The institution has selected the **Principal** and **five** teachers for the said course, which is to be approved by the Director, DTERT, Chennai.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **Nachiyarammal College of Physical Education, V.R. Nagar Village, Laxmi Puram P.O., Kovilpatti Taluk, Tuticorin District, Tamilnadu** for **C.P.Ed** course of **two years duration** from the academic session **2006-07** with an annual intake of **50** students, subject to fulfillment of the following;

- a. The institution will ensure that **Six** exclusive faculty members (**Principal and five teachers**) duly approved by the DTERT are in position for an intake of **50** students and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately and in any case before commencement of admissions for the course. The faculty list is to be approved by the Director, DTERT, Chennai.
- b. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.
- c. FDR for endowment fund should be converted in the joint name of the Regional Director, SRC-NCTE and the management represented if it is not already done.
- d. The institution should move to their own building within three years from the date of recognition of teacher training institute.


4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like the State Government etc.



5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the Directorate of Teacher Education Research and Training (DTERT) to the appointment of faculty members and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the Provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
