ORDER

In exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the National Council For Teacher Education(NCTE) Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee grants recognition to **Prince Marthanda Varma Teacher Training Institute, Peringara, Thiruvalla, Pathanamthitta District, Kerala - 689108** for **Elementary Course** of two years duration from the academic session **2000-2001** with an annual intake of **22**, subject to fulfilling the following conditions :

1. All such teachers already appointed who do not have qualifications as per NCTE norms shall acquire the qualifications as per the norms within a period of two years of this order.
2. The institution shall appoint within a period of one year, 4 additional teaching staff possessing the academic qualifications as laid down in the NCTE norms in the salary structure prescribed by the UGC/Central Government/State Government, as the case may be.
3. Librarian and Library Assistant should be appointed.
4. Physical Education teacher and instructors for Work Experience, Art & Music, and Education Technology should be appointed.
5. Science lab, Psychology lab and Art & Music room should be equipped as per NCTE norms.
6. Accommodation for Education Technology lab, Art & Music room & Store room should be provided as per NCTE norms.
7. 600 more books should be added to the library and three educational journals should be subscribed to as per NCTE norms.
8. The admission to the approved course shall be given only to those candidates who are eligible as per the regulations governing the course and in the manner laid down by the affiliating University/ State Government as the case may be.
9. Tuition fee and other fees will be charged from the students as per the norms of the affiliating University / State Government as the case may be till such time NCTE regulations in respect of fee structure come into force.
10. Curriculum transaction, including practical work / activities, should be organised as per the norms and standards for the course and the requirements of the affiliating University / examining body as the case may be.
11. Teaching days including practice teaching should not be less than the number fixed in the NCTE norms for the course.
