Preamble:

Sri.Kanakadas D.Ed College, C/o Beereshwar High School, No.289 & 290, Bilagi, Bagalkot – 587116, Karnataka had applied seeking for grant of recognition to D.Ed. course on 30.06.2008. The application was processed and an inspection was conducted to the institution on 14.3.2009. The VT report along with all necessary documents were placed before 172nd meeting of SRC held on 25-26 March, 2009 and SRC decided to issue Notice. Accordingly, Notice was issued on 16.4.2009.

The institution submitted its written representation on 25.4.2009 & 29.4.2009. SRC in its 175th meeting of SRC held on 13-14 May, 2009 considered the written representation and decided to cause re-inspection. The decision of SRC was communicated to the institution vide letter dt.2.6.2009. The institution vide letter dated 29.6.2009 has requested for postponement of the inspection.

The SRC in its 178th meeting held on 13-14 July 2009 considered the letter received on 3.7.2009 and decided to refuse recognition. Accordingly, Refusal order was issued to the institution on 30.07.2009.

The institution preferred appeal under section 18 of NCTE Act. The Appellate Authority considered the appeal and confirmed the refusal order of SRC vide order dated 12.04.2010.

Aggrieved by the Appellate Authority order, the institution filed W.P. 16446 of 2010 in the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka, Circuit Bench at Dharwad and the case has been Disposed of on 16.09.2010. The judgement reads as follows:

".... The writ petition is allowed. Impugned orders are set aside. The 1st respondent (SRC, NCTE) is directed to re-inspect the petitioner institution after fixing a date and after communicating the same to the institution. The decision regarding recognition can be taken in accordance with law thereafter."

Accordingly re-inspection was carried out on 10.11.2010 as per court directions.

SRC in its 199th meeting held on 22-23 December 2010 considered the VT report, VCD and all the relevant documents and decided to issue Showcause Notice. Accordingly, Showcause Notice was issued to the institution on 04.02.2011. The institution submitted its written representation on 22.02.2011. SRC in its 203rd meeting held on 31st March 2011 & 1st April 2011 and 204th meeting held on 27-28 April 2011 considered the written representation and decided to issue Letter of Intent. Accordingly, Letter of Intent was issued to the institution on 04.05.2011. The institution submitted reply on 18.05.2011.


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The SRC in its 205th meeting held on 18-19 May 2011 and 206th meeting held on 09-10 June 2011 considered the reply to LOI received on 27.05.2011 and 08.06.2011 and decided to issue formal recognition.

Hence the order.

ORDER


WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Shri.Kalidas Education Society, Torvi Road, Bijapur – 586102, Karnataka** has submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition **Sri.Kanakadas D.Ed College, C/o Beereshwar High School, No.289 & 290, Bilagi, Bagalkot – 587116, Karnataka** for conducting **D.Ed** course with an intake of 50 students on 30.06.2008.

2. AND WHEREAS on scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, institution fulfills the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the **Elementary** Teacher Education programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory etc. for running the programme and has appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.
3. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to **Sri.Kanakadas D.Ed College, C/o Beereshwar High School, No.289 & 290, Bilagi, Bagalkot – 587116, Karnataka** for conducting **D.Ed** Course of Two years duration with an annual intake of **50** students from the academic session **2011-12** under clause 7(11) of NCTE(Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009 and NCTE Amendment Regulation 2010 dated 26.07.2010 subject of fulfillment of the following conditions:
 - I. The endowment fund of Rs.5 lakhs and reserve fund of Rs.3 lakhs kept in joint account with SRC, NCTE should be maintained always. Loan raising or Mortgaging of FDRs shall not be done.
 - II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations; as amended from time to time.
 - III. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2007.
 - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc, as applicable. 

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5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
6. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-
 - (i) Copy of the Application Form
 - (ii) Land and Building Particulars
 - (iii) Staff Profile
 - (iv) Recognition letter
 - (v) Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.
7. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
