ORDER

Pursuant to the appellate order of the Council, New Delhi, No.F.No.89-239/2004-
Appeal dated 14th October 2004, the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE accords
recognition to **SNDSY Teacher Training Institute, Sreekandeswaram,
Poochackal P.O. Alleppey – 688526, Kerala** to offer **Elementary
Teacher Training course of two years duration** from the academic session
2004-2005 with an annual intake of **50** students.

2. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14 of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **SNDSY Teacher Training Institute, Sreekandeswaram, Poochackal P.O. Alleppey – 688526, Kerala** for **Elementary course of two years duration** from the academic session **2004-2005** with an annual intake of **50** students subject to fulfillment of the following.
 - a) The institution will ensure that **Six** faculty members are in position for an intake of **50** students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Committee immediately and in any case not later than one month from the date of commencement of the course.
 - b) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
 - c) The institution shall shift to its own premises within three years from the date of recognition (in case the course is started in temporary premises).
 - d) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.
3. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC / University / State Government etc.,



4. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating University for the appointment of faculty members and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
5. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
