WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely **KKBPED College, Plot No. 241 and 261, Tadogotla street, Tadigotla Village, KSRM Post Office, CK Dinne Taluk, Kadapa City and District – 516003, Andhra Pradesh** run by **Aisha Juwayriyah Minority Educational & Rural Development Society, Plot No. 7/477-5-2, Bhagya Nagar Colony, Chinna Chawk Post Office, Kadapa – 516002, Andhra Pradesh** vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/SRCAPP189/B.P.Ed/API/2015/62207 dated 03.03.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students (one unit).

AND WHEREAS, on 17.03.2015, the institution submitted a request vide letter dated 16.03.2015 for grant of recognition from the academic year 2014 -15 and permit the applicant to go for spot admissions for the academic year 2014-15.

AND WHEREAS, as advised, a letter was addressed to the institution on 12.05.2015 stating that since recognition is granted from the year 2015-2016 the institution shall not to make admissions for the year 2014-15.

AND WHEREAS, on 10.06.2015, an email was received from the advocate Shri.Ramakanth Reddy enclosing a copy of the affidavit filed by the institution in W.P.No. 16054 of 2015. On 13.07.2015, a letter is received from the Govt. Pleader for School Education , High court of Hyderabad stating that the writ petition is disposed on 30.06.2015. On 14.07.2015, the institution has submitted a representation.

AND WHEREAS, on 31.07.2015, certified copy of the Court order dated 13.06.2015 in W.P.No. 16054 of 2015 is received by this office which is as under :-

::ORDER::

Heard Sri V.R. Reddy Kovvuri, learned counsel for the petitioners and Sri K. Ramakanth Reddy, learned Standing Counsel for respondents 1 & 2.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioners that the representation dated 16.03.2015 submitted by the petitioners herein to the Regional Director of National Council for Teacher Education, New Delhi-second respondent herein is pending consideration and the same may be directed to be disposed of.

In that view of the matter, the writ petition is disposed of, directing the 2nd respondent herein to consider the representation dated 16.03.2015 said to have been submitted by the petitioners herein and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

The miscellaneous petitions, if any, filed in this writ petition shall also stand disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.

AND WHEREAS, the representation of the institution dated 16.03.2015 is detailed above. The SRC in its 291st meeting held on 20th – 22nd August, 2015 considered the matter decided as under:-

“In compliance of the court order, the representation of the petitioner institution is considered and the request cannot be accepted in view of the Hon’ble Supreme Court order.”

AND WHEREAS, the institution vide letter dated 26.10.2019, 26.12.2019 and 26.01.2020 submitted written representation. The SRC in its 384th meeting held during 12th to 13th February, 2020 considered the matter and decided as under;

The Committee decided that to withdraw the recognition granted to KBBPED College, Andhra Pradesh for conducting B.P.Ed course under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the request of the institution vide its letter dated 26.01.2020. However, the FDRs towards Reserve Fund and Endowment Fund/ No Objection Certificate (NOC) for encashment of FDRs will be issued by the Regional Director on the submission of the following:

- (a) NOC from the affiliating body.**
- (b) NOC from the staff/faculty.**
- (c) Resolution of the management to the effect for closure of the course**

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of **KKBPED College, Plot No. 241 and 261, Tadogotla street, Tadigotla Village, KSRM Post Office, CK Dinne Taluk, Kadapa City and District – 516003, Andhra Pradesh** run by **Aisha Juwayriyah Minority Educational & Rural Development Society, Plot No. 7/477-5-2, Bhagya Nagar Colony, Chinna Chawk Post Office, Kadapa – 516002, Andhra Pradesh** for conducting B.P.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (one unit) from the next academic session starts after issuance of this order.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
